Subject: 2017 Division Festival of Talents
Date: October 18, 2017

1. The Department of Education, Baguio City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS on November 14, 2017, 8:00 AM at Lucban Elementary School Baguio City.
2. The Festival aims to provide the school learners (both public and private) with opportunities to showcase their talents through exhibitions of performances as evidence of their learning.
3. The Festival of Talents consists of the following competencies and skills exhibition in Araling Panlipunan and Filipino.

ARALING PANLIPUNAN

A. QUIZ BEE (ELEMENTARY)

Grade 5 Cordillera History
Grade 6 Philippine History

QUIZ BEE (SECONDARY)

Grade 7 - Asian History
Grade 8 - World History
Grade 9 - ECONOQUIZ
Grade 10 - POPQUIZ

B. On- The- Spot Skills Exhibition (SECONDARY)

ESSAY WRITING - (Grade 10)
POSTER MAKING - (Grade 9 or 10)
JINGLE WRITING and SINGING (Grade 9 or 10)

3. The Top two (2) district winners in the Elementary Quiz Bee and Top three (3) winners in QUIZ BEE, Secondary, and on —the- Spot Skills Exhibition are the qualified contestants in the Division.
4. Each district will submit sets of questions per Grade Level for the QUIZ BEE Category. Five (5) EASY questions, Five (5) AVERAGE questions, and Five (5) DIFFICULT questions. The questions will be placed in short brown envelope, sealed and to be submitted at the Division Office c/o MARINA D. TABANGCURA, Ph. D., Educ. Program Supervisor, Araling Panlipunan on November 3, 2017.
5. A registration fee of one hundred pesos(Php 100.00) will be collected to defray expenses on the materials for the quiz, certificates, token for the Board of Judges, and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of DFOT.

6. The specific guidelines for each area skills exhibition are contained in the following enclosures.
7. For the areas of competition and guidelines of the Filipino subject, a memorandum will follow.
8. Wide and immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is highly enjoined.

GUIDELINES on the QUIZ BEE and on- the- spot Skills Exhibition

A. QUIZ BEE (Elementary and Secondary)

1. The top two winners in the ELEMENTARY District competition and the Top three (3) winners in the SECONDARY competition are the official participants in the QUIZ BEE.
2. During the quiz, participants will be provided with writing sheets.
3. English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
4. Participants will be given thirty (30) questions, of which ten (10) are "Easy", ten (10) are "Average" and ten (10) are "Difficult".

Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:

Two (2) points for each " EASY" question

Three (3) points for each " AVERAGE " question

Five (5) points for each " DIFFICULT" question

5. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. For questions that require computation , participants shall be given a maximum of thirty (30) seconds.
6. The quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
7. A division record holder will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring.
8. All ties shall be broken by a tiebreaker question from the "difficult" category.
9. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:
 - Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
 - The person in charge of the activity upon deliberation will announce the decision.
10. Only the first place winner is qualified to join in the regional competition.

B. On- the- spot Skills Exhibition (SECONDARY)

1. The top three (3) winners from each District are the official participants in the Division.
2. The theme of the showcase will be announced on the actual day of the skills exhibition.
3. The organizers will provide the contestants the writing pad to be used in writing. For the Poster Making contest, the participants will bring their own materials.
4. Essay must be at least 800 but not more than 1000 words in English and legibly written in double space in the provided writing pad. Essay must be original.
5. Any artwork in the poster must be original in design.
6. The jingle must be an original composition highlighting the theme. Lyrics must be in English. Performance must be done within two to three minutes.
7. Criteria for judging shall be based on the following;
