# Jingle Making Contest Mechanics and Criteria

## I. Mechanics:

1. The contest is open to all grade 10 of the 16 public high schools.
2. Each group is composed of 5 members.
3. The jingle message is "Step out" from the trend of teenage pregnancy.
4. The jingle must be in English and must not exceed 3 minutes playing time.
5. Lyrics should not contain vulgar and rude words. Violation of this guidelines will result to disqualification.
6. The contestants will be prejudged by the school and the winner will represent the school. The list of a.) names of the members b.) name of school c.) name of the coach and contact number of the winner will be submitted to Population Office, HSO on November 23, 2017 from 8:00am to 5:00 pm.
7. Final judging of the winning group will present their jingle on November 24, 2017 at 9:00 in the morning at the Conference Hall, Health Services Office.
8. Each team can be accompanied by their respective coach.
9. There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners. Consolation prizes will be given to non-winners.

3.) Stage Presence .....	10%
(Confidence & suitable attire)	
4.) Timing . . . . .	10%
5.) Originality.....	10%
6.) Overall impact.....	10%
