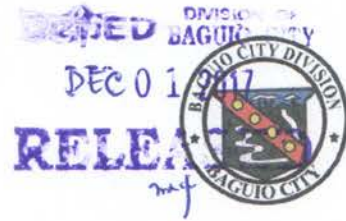

Subject :2018 CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS
CONFERENCE (RSPC)

Date :November 29, 2017

1. In line with the thrusts to promote responsible and free journalism pursuant to the provision of Section 2 RA 7079, DepEd Baguio shall actively participate in the **Conduct of the 2018 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) on December 5-8, 2017 at Tabuk City.**

2. With the theme, *"Embracing ASEAN Integration: Campus Journalists' Role in Advancing Inclusive Education"*, the said Press Conference will have the following activities in the elementary and secondary, English and Filipino, including individual, group and paper contests; concurrent sessions, and Search for Outstanding SPAs and Campus Journalists (CJs), (kindly refer to Regional Memo No. 367, series 2017 for details).

3. The participants are the winners-top 5 in the individual category, including top 1 in the collaborative, radio and TV (secondary only) broadcasting categories; top 10 in the group contest/school paper category, and top 2 candidates for Outstanding SPAs and CJs, (kindly refer to the enclosure for the list of winners under Memo No. 412, series 2017). Additional names as replacements include the following:

- a. Julliana Laron (PCNHS) for Editorial Writing (English-Secondary) for Marianne Nicole Hujilla (UBSHS)
- b. Warren Ambat (HT, English-BCNHS) for Armi Victoria Fiangaan (EPS-English, OIC)
- c. Maylyn Samidan (HT, Filipino-BCNHS)

4. A registration fee of five hundred fifty pesos (P550.00) shall be charged against local funds/SEF subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations. This will cover honoraria of judges, trophies, kits, supplies and other operational expenses.

5. Likewise, transportation with the amount of P1,100.00 (back and forth) will be charged against the SEF funds, however, food or meal allowance (P990.00) and incidental expenses shall be charged from the school MOOE, PTA, canteen or school paper fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations.

6. Billeting school will be at Bulanao Central Elementary School at Tabuk City, hence participants are advised to bring beddings if possible. Travel date and time is on November 4, 2017, 10:00 in the evening and meeting place is at BCNHS parking area.

7. In addition are the following reminders:

- a. wear T-shirt/blouse with violet color for the parade;
 - b. with ID and copy of the school paper;
 - c. bring own equipment for identified contests (i.e. point and shoot camera with memory card, laptop, printer, speakers, sound system etc.),
 - d. observe punctuality and etiquette.
- Please be guided accordingly.
