- 1. In relation to DepEd Regional Memorandum no. 366, series of 2017, the Training on Pedagogical Retooling in Mathematics, Languages and Science (PRIMALS) will be conducted on January 15-22, 2018 at Brentwood Apartelle, Baguio City.
- 2. Specifically, this training aims to enhance the reading and literacy skills of Grades 4 to 6 learners in English and Filipino, likewise with other content areas such as Mathematics and Science following the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum by establishing a sustainable and cost effective professional development component of the said program.
- 3. Hence, enclosed is the list of participants from the Baguio City Division, which is under Batch 2, together with Benguet, Ifugao and Mt. Province. Attendance is highly expected. Kindly refer also to the attached regional memo for additional details.
- 4. Accommodation and meals for 7 days will be charged to PRIMALS fund. First meal is dinner on January 15 and last meal is afternoon snacks on January 22. Travel expenses and other meals not covered within the training will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Participants will be entitled to service credits or Compensatory Time Off for January 20 and 21.
- 6. Reminders include the following:
- a. Participants should not be nursing mothers and bringing of kids is not allowed;
- b. Participants are requested to bring laptops, extension cords and pocket WIFI, and

- c. School heads/Teachers are encouraged to take appropriate actions to avoid disruption of classes.



REGIONAL TRAINING ON PEDAGOGICAL RETOOLING IN MATHEMATICS, LANGUAGES AND SCIENCE (PRIMALS) FOR GRADES IV TO VI TEACHERS

- With reference to DepEd Memorandum-CI-2017-00117 entitled Pedagogical Retooling in Mathematics, Languages and Science (PRIMALS), and to ensure the continuity of the Implementation of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2015 entitled Early Language Literacy and Numeracy DepEd-CAR will conduct the Regional Training on January 8-14, 2018 for Batch 1 at HoteLinda, Vigan City and on January 15-22, 2018 for Batch 2 at Brentwood, Bagulo City.
- 2. The purpose of this Training Program is to develop in Filipino children their communicative, scientific, and mathematical skills, and attitudes which will contribute to lifelong learning. More specifically, it aims to enhance the reading and literacy skills of Grade 4 to 6 learners in English and Filipino, as well as in other content areas such as mathematics and science, following the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, by establishing a sustainable and cost effective professional development component of the program.
- 3. Participants to be trained should come from the first batch of schools trained in the ELLN for continuity purposes. The training in ELLN is for Kinder to Grade 3 (first key stage) teachers while PRIMALS is for Grades 4 to 6 (second key stage) teachers. Batch 1 will be composed of participants from the Divisions of Abra, Apayao, Kalinga and Tabuk City. Batch 2 will be composed of participants from the Divisions of Mt. Province, Ifugao, Baguio City and Benguet.
- 4. Attendance to this significant activity is highly expected from the Regional Office, the Regional Training Team, and Division participants as specified below:

- 6. Accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning and afternoon snacks) for 7 days will be charged to downloaded funds for PRIMALS. First meal for Batch 1 will be dinner of Sunday, January 7, and last meal will be afternoon snacks of Sunday January 14, Sunday. First meal for Batch 2 will be dinner of Monday, January 15 and last meal will be afternoon Snacks of Monday, January 22, 2018. Meals will be served.
- The Regional PRIMALS Training Team are requested to attend the pre-planning activity on December 22, 2017 from 8:00am to 5:00pm.
- Travel expenses and other meals not covered within the workshop duration will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Participants and Training Management Team will be entitled to service credits or Compensatory time off (CTO) as per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2015 in lieu of January 13 & 14 for those attending Batch 1 and January 20 & 21 for those attending Batch 2.
- 10. School heads of teacher participants are encouraged to take appropriate actions to avoid disruption of classes. School heads must make arrangements with available teachers in the School to take charge of classes of teachers who will be attending the training.
- 11. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this memorandum is directed.
