Moreover, to give chance to develop camaraderie among the participants.

4. Participants to this activity are the top 3 winners in the different contested skills from the six (6) elementary districts and four (4) secondary districts which were participated in by public and private schools.

Each participant (Contestant or Coach) shall pay a registration fee of Fifty (50.00) pesos to cover the food (snacks/lunch) and transportation allowance of guests and judges charged to the school/ PTA/MOOE/Canteen fund and other source of fund while certificates and invitation programs will be charged to the Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
6. A solidarity meeting of all steering committees and coaches will be on January 19, 2018, 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Baguio City National High School Library. All clarifications, issues and concerns relative to the Technolympics shall be addressed during this meeting.
7. Teacher- participant shall be granted a one (1) day service credit and COC to Non-teaching personnel for services rendered on January 28, 2018 that falls on a Sunday.
