2018 CONDUCT OF NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

TO: Public Schools District Supervisors,
Public and Private School Administrators (Elementary and Secondary)

- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) and the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), announces the conduct of the 2018 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) with the theme, "Embracing ASEAN Integration: Campus Journalists' Role in Advancing Inclusive Education" on February 19-23, 2018 in Dumaguete City. The host region is Region VI.
- This is pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and in compliance to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2010, entitled Guidelines on Financial Subsidy for the Conduct of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) specifically Rule IX of Section 1.

3. The Conference aims to:

- a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness and environmental awareness;
- c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in Journalism as a career or those who intend to use skill sets learned through campus journalism to give them a better edge in their chosen careers;
- d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media;
 and
- e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.

- Each participant from public and private schools, included in the official list of Delegation, please be reminded of the following:
 - a. Registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P 4,000.00-registration fee shall cover the costs of board and lodging, kits, including conference materials, rental of equipment/vehicle, payment for utilities, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of NSPC) charged to Regional funds including the bus fare of one thousand one hundred seventy six pesos and fifty centavo (Php.1,176.50 for Bacolod to Dumaguete; Dumaguete to Bacolod);
 - b. Seven Thousand two hundred and twenty two Pesos (Php.7,222.00) plane fare of the student and teacher participants will be coming from the Special Education Fund, including the bus fare of one thousand two hundred Pesos (1,200.00, Baguio to Manila and Manila to Baguio).
 - c. Other incidental expenses and food allowances of the participants since the first meal shall be served lunch of February 19, 2018 Sunday and the last meal shall be afternoon snack of February 23, 2018 will be coming from the School MOOE/Funds (private schools) /PTA/Canteen funds or the School Campus Journalism Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
