**URGING ALL UNIVERSITIES, COLLEGES, AND PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO TO CREATE 'LEARNING NETWORKS' WITHIN THEIR CAMPUSES THAT WOULD CONDUCT TUTORIALS OR REMEDIAL CLASSES ON THE SUBJECTS MATH, SCIENCE, AND ENGLISH, AMONG OTHERS, FOR ITS STUDENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the *Global Competitiveness Index* is a yearly report published by the World Economic Forum which presents a framework and a corresponding set of indicators in three principal categories (subindexes) and 12 policy domains (pillars) for 137 economies;

**WHEREAS**, in the 2017-2018 *Global Competitiveness Index*, the Philippines ranked only 76<sup>th</sup> with a mark of 3.9/7.0 in the assessment as to the quality of math and science education in our country;

**WHEREAS**, in the report of the *Third International Mathematics and Science Study-Repeat*, which focuses on the mathematics and science achievements of students of participating nations, Filipino students were found to be weak in math and science;

**WHEREAS**, there is then a need to enhance math and science education in our country, though the City of Baguio can only do as much as ensuring that our students in the city are assisted on such through tutorials, remedial classes, and the like; and

**WHEREAS**, learning networks or groups of volunteers (composed of teachers and/or students) that would provide tutorials or remedial classes on different subjects has been found to be effective in said cause.

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of all, seconded by all,


**RESOLVED**, as it hereby resolved, to urge all universities, colleges, and primary and secondary schools in the City of Baguio to create 'learning networks' within their campuses that would conduct tutorials or remedial classes on the subjects Math, Science, and English, among others, for its students.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the Commission on Higher Education-CAR, Department of Education-CAR, and the City Schools Division of Baguio City, in coordination with the City Government of Baguio's Council for Student Welfare, reconstituted under Administrative Order No. 074, s. 2017, come up with a plan on the creation and implementation of 'learning networks' in all universities, colleges, and primary and secondary schools in the City of Baguio.
