It aims to strengthen free and responsible journalism in Junior High School and develop the learners' skills required in mass communication particularly in print and broadcast media. Its focus is primarily on the mastery of competencies required to land a noble and prolific career in journalism.

Admission is open to all incoming Grade 7 learners who exhibit talent in journalism based on the results of the qualifying examinations and interview to be conducted by the school screening committee.

3. Requirements and Fees:

Each applicant must submit his/her :

- Duly accomplished application form
- Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag
- Photocopy of Grade 6 Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCNHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement

General Average of 85% or higher (add and <i>divide the</i> 3 general averages obtained from 1 st to 3 rd Grading period)
Average of 85% or higher (add and <i>divide the</i> grades in English obtained from 1 st to 3 rd Grading period)
Average of 85% or higher (add and <i>divide the</i> grades in Filipino obtained from 1 st to 3 rd Grading period)
No grades lower than 80% in the other subjects (1 st to 3 rd Grading periods)

- Certification of Good Moral Character from Elementary Principal
- Recommendation Letter from the school paper adviser or English/ Filipino Teacher in Grade 6
- Photocopy of certificates of recognition for applicants who have participated and won in previous school, division, regional or national schools press conferences (if available)
- Two Hundred Fifty Pesos examination fee for test materials, honorarium for testing personnel and other incidental expenses

4. **Filing Period** : February 12 to April 12, 2018 ONLY at Baguio City National High School Guidance Services Office during office hours. No processing of applications on the day before the test (April 13, 2018) and test day (April 14, 2018) to give ample time for testing personnel to prepare the testing rooms and test materials.

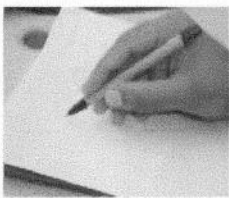
