



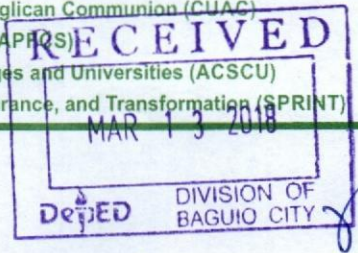

CONTESTS GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

5th Easter College Academic Festival

April 3, 2018

A. General Guidelines:

1. All participants must be currently enrolled for the school 2017-2018.
2. There will be three categories: Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School.
3. A contestant is only allowed to join a single event of the competition.
4. Participating school can field more than one contestant in any event.
5. A registration fee of Php 100.00 will be charged from each participant (coach is free).
6. Punctuality is a must. A 10-minute defaulting time will be given for late comers in a particular vent.
7. All entries shall become the property of Easter College.
8. All decisions of the Board of Judges and Chairpersons will be final and irrevocable.
9. Determination of winners – ranking system.
 1. Medal and certificate of recognition will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers in each event and certificate of participation for all participants.
10. Participants are encouraged to register on or before April 2, 2018. You may send the scanned copy of the registration form to i_liwanen@yahoo.com.

C. Specific Guidelines:

1. Quiz Bee
 - a. Each group should compose of three (3) members.
 - b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit four questions (one easy, one average, one difficult, and one clincher). It should be type/computer written in a one fourth crosswise of a letter size bond paper (8.5 X 13).
 - c. Time allotment and point per category are as follows:

Questions with Computation

Easy	-10 sec	-20 sec	- 1 pt.	-Multiple Choice (4 choices)
Average	- 15 sec	-40 sec	- 2 pts.	-Multiple Choice (4 choices)
Difficult	- 20 sec	-60 sec	- 3 pts.	-Identification

- d. All questions must be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- e. Questions will be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "GO." The time limit will begin with the word "GO" by the quizmaster. For questions requiring computation, contestants can start solving while the quizmaster is reading the question.
- f. In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.

g. Coverage:

h. All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next question.

i. Any violation of the aforementioned rules shall cause the disqualification of the contestant concerned or of the question submitted.

2. Spelling Bee

a. Each group should compose of three (3) members.

b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit four spelling words (one easy, one average, one difficult, and one clincher), using the Standard English. It should be type/computer written in a one fourth crosswise of a letter size bond paper (8.5 X 13).

c. All spelling words should be used in a sentence which shall be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.

d. Time allotment and point per category are as follows:

Easy	-15 seconds	- 1 pt.
Average	- 20 seconds	- 2 pts.
Difficult	- 25 seconds	- 3 pts.

e. Spelling words will be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "GO." The time limit will begin with the word "GO" by the quizmaster.

f. All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next spelling word.

g. In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.

h. Any violation of the aforementioned rules shall cause the disqualification of the contestant concerned or of the question submitted.

3. Poster Making and Painting:

a. The concept/idea should revolve around the theme given/announced before the contest proper.

b. The contestant must provide his/her own materials (poster – oil pastel, painting – poster paint).

c. The piece must be done on a 1/8 illustration board which must also be brought by the contestant.

d. The allotted time is 2 hours. After which, all entries shall be submitted to the chairperson. Contestant may decide to submit his/her output earlier without waiting for the lapse of 2 hours.

e. The criteria for judging are:

Relevance to the theme	- 30%
Creativity/ Originality	- 25%
Harmony of Colors	- 25%
Aesthetics	- 20%

- f. In case of tie, the decision shall be based on the first criterion. If it fails to break the tie, the next criterion shall be used, and so on until no more ties exist.
4. Essay Writing Contest (English and Filipino)
- The essay must be written in English or Filipino, as the case may be, and should contain not less than 300 words but not more than 800 words including articles. Three percent of the total score shall be deducted for non compliance of this rule.
 - The contestant shall be given 120 minutes to compose and write their pieces. The contestant may or may not provide a title for hi/her essay. The theme will not be considered as the title.
 - The facilitators will provide the writing papers for the participants. The participants are not allowed to bring an outline for their essays. The reverse sheet of the paper shall be used.
 - The criteria for judging shall be:

Content	- 30%
Unity and Coherence	- 25%
Originality	- 20%
Grammar/Language	- 15%
Neatness	- 10%
 - In case of tie, the decision shall be based on the first criterion. If it fails to break the tie, the next criterion shall be used, and so on until no more ties exist.
5. Extemporaneous Speech (for Junior and Senior High School only)
- All speech must be delivered in English.
 - The generic question to be discussed by the contestants shall be prepared by the contest committee.
 - Each contestant shall be given three minutes to prepare for hi/her piece and three minutes to deliver it. A deduction of 3% from the average for every excess of one minute shall be applied.
 - No participant shall be allowed to read from his/her note and to carry with him/her any electronic device.
 - Criteria:

Content	-40%
Voice and Diction	-40%
Stage Presence	-20%
