**PRIVATE SCHOOLS' K TO 12 TRANSITION PLAN APPROVAL  
AS REITERATED in DO No. 06, s. 2018**

1. DepEd Order 06, s. 2018 "School Year 2017-2018 K to 12 Basic Education Program End of School Year Rites" reiterates one of the requirements for Graduation of Grade 12 learners from schools with DepEd-approved K to 12 transition plan.
2. This had long been emphasized in 2013 and implemented in 2014 under DepEd Order No. 43, s. 2013 which is the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 10533 otherwise known as the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013. Section 29 "Private Basic Educational Institutions' Transition to the Enhanced Basic Education Program" stipulates that **private educational institutions shall develop their plans detailing how to transition from their current Basic Education System to the Enhanced Basic Education Program. They shall submit to DepEd their transition plans within twelve (12) months from the effectivity of this IRR.**
3. Since this is a requirement for the Senior High School Graduation for SY 2017-2018, private schools with School Of Tomorrow (SOT) or Accelerated Christian Education (ACE) and other similar programs will prepare and submit K to 12 Transition Plan. Prior to the endorsement to the Regional Office for the its approval, all schools that offered the aforementioned system/program will have coordination meeting on April 18, 2018, 8 a.m. at the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Conference Hall. Please bring your Transition Plan draft/final copy.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
