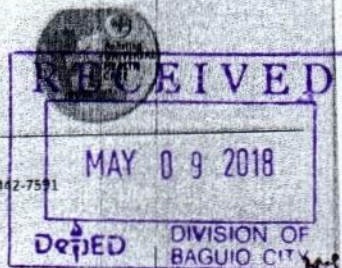

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

**Provincial/ City DepEd Advocacy Meeting on School-based Health Programs**

**I. Rationale:**

School children are among the vulnerable age groups in terms of health status. Poor health status of children may greatly affect their cognitive performance including their physical development. To ensure better health status of the learners and disease-free schools, the Department of Education, in partnership with the Department of Health, is implementing various school-based health programs. Among these is the deworming which is being conducted twice a year.

Yearly, a Regional DepEd advocacy Meeting is being conducted to review program accomplishments, provides program updates and to discuss the gaps and challenges in program implementation. Other school-based health programs updates are also discussed and advocated during the activity.

A provincial roll-out activity of the Regional DepEd Advocacy Meeting is deemed important to provide feedbacks, updates and to advocate school-based health programs to teachers, Parent Teachers Association and other health personnel to promote a disease free-school and community.
