**100 YEARS OF ROVER SCOUTING
(13th NATIONAL ROVER MOOT FOR LUZON, VISAYAS AND MINDANAO)**

1. We are pleased to invite Rover Scouts, Roverettes and Adult Leaders to the 100 Years of Rover Scouting for Luzon, Visayan and Mindanao) on August 26 - 31, 2018 with the following venue:

LUZON:	Camp Kainomayan, Barangay San Juan Botolan, Zambales
VISAYAS:	Capitol Hills, Scout Camp Cebu City
MINDANAO:	Pasonanca Park Zamboanga City


2. The Rover Moot aims to provide safe, exciting, challenging and meaningful learning opportunities and educational activities geared towards responsible leadership, community development, environment and natural resources protection and preservation and build lasting friendship among brotherhood of open-air and service.

3. **Qualification for participation:** The following are the minimum qualifications for participating Rovers, Rover leaders and NSTs, viz:
 - a. **Rover Scouts** is expected to have leadership skills and potentials and enough camping experience:
 - o Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle in good standing
 - o Must be at least sixteen (16) but not more than twenty-six (26) years old; and those who are in the Junior and Senior High School in the Rovers Scouting Section
 - o Must have a Health and Medical Certificate as certified by a physician
 - o Must have Parent's Permit for participants below 18 years old
 - o Must a complete set of camping gears and equipment.

 - b. **Rover Leaders** must have undergone the Basic Training and/or preferably with Advance Training Course for Unit Leaders and understanding of his/her duties and responsibilities as Adult Leaders:
 - o Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle
 - o Must be physically fit as certified by a physician
 - o Must be of good moral character
 - o Must be equipped with camping gears
 - o Preferably a bead holder or a graduate of the Advanced Training Course for Unit Leaders or Leader of Adults.

 - c. A standard radio of one (1) Leader for every nine (9) Rovers must be observed in the composition of Moot contingents.


