**ORIENTATION ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED
PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL-IRI)**

To: **Public Schools District Supervisors (Elementary and Secondary)
School Heads (Elementary and Secondary)
Teachers Concerned**

1. This is to inform the field that there will be an **Orientation on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) for School Year 2018-2019 on June 29, 2018 from 8:00 in the morning up to 12 noon at the Division Office Training Center.**
2. The Phil-IRI is used as a classroom-based assessment tool which aims to measure and describe the learners' reading performance in both English and Filipino languages in oral reading, silent reading and listening comprehension. The data shall also serve as one of the bases in planning, designing/redesigning the reading instruction of the teachers and the school's reading programs or activities to improve the overall school's reading performance.
3. Identified participant is one per school (total of 66), either the Phil-IRI coordinator or English/Filipino teacher (1 from Grades 3-6 for the elementary, 1 from Grade 7 for the secondary). Morning snack will be provided charged from the Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations.
4. Administration of the Phil-IRI Pretest (Group Screening Test) is July 13 onwards and submission of said results is on July 31. For more details, kindly refer to *DepEd Order no. 14 s. 2018 (Policy Guidelines on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI))*.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
