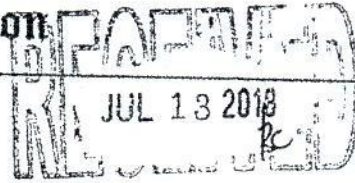



DATE : July 3, 2017

1. This refers to the conduct of the subject activity on July 23-26, 2018 which will be held in Lingayen, Pangasinan. The exact venue shall be announced by DepEd - Indigenous Peoples Education Office (IPsEO) later.
2. In the pursuit of the foundational principles of DepEd Order 62, s. 2011 - inclusion, participation and empowerment - and in full recognition, respect and promotion of the rights of Indigenous Peoples to education, the Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Program of the Department of Education has ensured the participation and inclusion of the Indigenous Peoples communities and the inclusion of Indigenous Knowledge in the development of the IPEd Program. The current involvement of the Indigenous Peoples communities, particularly their indigenous knowledge systems, in contextualizing DepEd's curriculum and governance systems, mechanisms and processes of DepEd, demands a continuous dialogue with the Indigenous Cultural Communities (ICCs) through their representatives. The continuous dialogue will facilitate the process of contextualizing the national education system for IPEd.
3. The subject activity is envisioned to be an opportunity for the IP elders from the Cordilleras, Sierra Madre and Ilocandia for consensus building on key concepts, processes, mechanisms and procedures vital to the current developments in IPEd. It also intends to be an avenue for dialogue with DepEd regarding community concerns and the institutionalization of the continuing dialogue of the ICCs with DepEd.

4. Participants to the activity are the key elders from the Indigenous Peoples Communities of the Cordilleras, Sierra Madre and Ilocandia. From DepEd, participants are IPEd Regional and Alternate Focal Persons, IPEd Division Focal Persons, CLMD, ESSD, CID and SGOD Chiefs from Regions I, II, and CAR. Please refer to Attachment 1 for the details.
5. To finalize preparations for the Congress, a pre-conference will be held on July 10, 2018. For the evaluation of the activity process and to gather recommendations for future consideration, a post-conference will be held on July 27, 2017. The IPEd Regional and Alternate Focal Persons of the concerned regions are requested to participate in the pre- and post-Congress activities.
6. The participants are requested to observe the following:
  - For the pre-conference, the IPEd Regional and Alternate Focal Persons are expected to arrive on the afternoon of July 9, 2018 (Monday) – first meal shall be dinner of the same day; last meal is breakfast of July 11, 2018 (Wednesday)
  - For the Congress proper, the IPEd Regional and Alternate Focal Persons are expected to arrive on the afternoon of July 22, 2018 (Sunday) while the rest of the participants (**see attachment 1**) are expected to arrive at the venue on the afternoon of July 23, 2018 (Monday)– first meal shall be dinner of the same day; last meal is breakfast of July 27, 2018 (Friday)
  - For the post-conference, the IPEd Regional and Alternate Focal Persons are expected to depart from the venue on the morning of July 28, 2018 (Saturday) – last meal is breakfast of the same day.
  - In preparing your travel authority, please consider the required travel time to reach the venue to ensure that you **arrive on time for the start of the activity and leave the venue at the end of the Program**. It has been observed in past activities that some focal persons either arrive late and/or leave earlier than what is prescribed in the program.
  - Please refer to Attachment 2 for the Activity Design of the Congress proper.
7. Travel expenses of DepEd participants shall be charged to/reimbursed from the Region/Division IPEd Program Support Fund while the travel expenses of IP Community Representatives and the non-DepEd members of the training team shall be charged to/reimbursed from the funds for this activity downloaded to DepEd Schools Division of Pangasinan I (payment of which shall also be disbursed by the said division office), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. The honoraria of attending IP Community Representative shall be charged to the funds for this activity downloaded to DepEd Schools Division of Pangasinan I (payment of which shall also be disbursed by the said division office), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The provision of honoraria shall be based on the Unnumbered DepEd Memorandum dated June 5, 2017 (Provision of Honoraria to Indigenous Peoples (IP) Community Resource Persons and Payment of Travel Expenses of IP Community Representatives Invited to IPEd Program Activities).
