3. The Division Technical Working Group for OK sa DepEd shall ensure the implementation of this policy and shall be composed of the following:

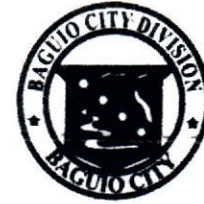
