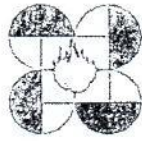

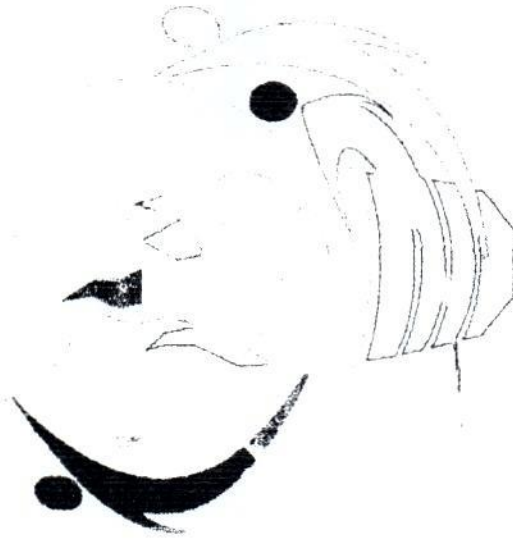

LAGABLAB

With the theme, "LAGABLAB: Igniting the Youth's Passion for Science, Innovation and Progress", the Regional Science Camp (RSC) aims to stimulate the scientific values among the youth in the Cordilleras.

The event is a 2-day region-wide gathering of Grade 5 & 6 students in CAR who are members of the science clubs in their respective schools. Alongside these elementary students, selected scholars from the organizing school will be participating in the activities. The camp serves as the setting for the region's youth to gain new experiences through aptitudes of Science, leaning towards the direction of engineering, through various competitions, activities, and workshops designed. Aside from this, it allows interaction between and among the elementary and high school students, and provide the younger participants with figures for guidance and a glimpse of what it's like to be students of Pisay.

THINGS TO BRING

- Towels
- Toiletries
- Working clothes and rubber shoes (t-shirts, shorts, pants, comfy clothes)
- Drinking Water Containers
- Mosquito-Repellent Lotion
- Personal Medicine or other needs for allergies or other medical conditions
- White Outfit (can be a shirt or dress)
- Money for Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner ₱50 per meal)
- Sleeping bags and blankets
- Tents (optional but highly recommended)

EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

ENGINEERING CHALLENGE

Students will be tasked to create an engineering project that challenges their creativity and resourcefulness. The constructed project shall be presented during the camp for judging. The scoring shall be based on efficiency, durability, functionality and aesthetics of the project.

SUBCAMP QUIZ BOWL

A quiz bowl will be done for the subcamps that will involve around the concepts in Engineering. All members of each respective subcamp will be given the chance to answer a question.

POSTER MAKING

Simultaneous with the Science and the Essay Writing contest, the Poster Making Contest shall take place. Only one representative per school shall be allowed to join the activity. The specific theme for the poster contest would be given on the spot, but will still revolve around the field of Engineering and the main theme of the Regional Science Camp.

HATAW

A hataw session will be held prior to the activities of the second day in order to prepare the participants for the upcoming challenges, which will stimulate their bodies and minds.

SCIENCE RACE

Simultaneous with the Poster Making and the Essay Writing contest, the Science Race shall take place. The competing teams will be the different sub-camp and it will be participated by at most 5 students per school. It will be composed of students with specific tasks to be completed.

INVENTION AND INNOVATION EXPO

Each sub-camp will present its product to the workshops and the take-home challenge in a one-hour invention and innovation expo. Participants may also present their own projects from the schools in the activity. Aside from these, students from Philippine Science High School - CABC will have projects they have attempted that are related in the field of engineering. These projects are given additional awards.

ESSAY WRITING

Simultaneous with the Science Race and the Poster Making contest, the Essay Writing Contest shall take place. Only one representative per school shall be allowed to join the activity. The specific theme for the essay-writing contest would be given on the spot, but will still revolve around the field of Engineering and the main theme of the Regional Science Camp.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

A grade 5 or grade 6 elementary pupil from a duly recognized school by the Department of Education who meets the following criteria is eligible to apply for the Regional Science Camp (RSC):

He/She must:

- have a final grade of 85% or better in Science and Mathematics, evidenced by the student's report card. If the student's grades in Science or Math are below 85%, then, he/she must provide evidence that he/she belongs to the upper 10% of the class.
- be a Filipino citizen with no pending or approved application as immigrant to any foreign country;
- have at least a satisfactory rating (or its equivalent) in his/her Character Rating in his/her report card (SY 2017-2018);
- preferably, be in good health and fit to undergo rigorous activities.
