**DECLARING THE MORNING OF 28 SEPTEMBER 2018, 8:00 AM TO 12:00 NOON, AS COMMUNITY SERVICE DAY IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO AS OUR CONTRIBUTION TO THE CELEBRATION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ANNIVERSARY AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE PURPOSE.**

**WHEREAS**, The Civil Service Commission will be celebrating its 118<sup>th</sup> Philippine Civil Service Anniversary on 28 September 2018;

**WHEREAS**, LGU's are likewise encouraged to conduct appropriate programs as an active participant for this annual celebration'

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for the officials and employees of the City Government to show an example to the people on the effective and efficient management of their solid waste at source for the people to emulate;

**WHEREAS**, holding community service day in the morning of 28 September 2018 will make the celebration of the Civil Service Anniversary even more meaningful;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, MAURICIO G. DOMOGAN**, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the morning of 28 September 2018, 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon as Community Service Day as our contribution for the celebration of the Civil Service Anniversary providing guidelines for the purpose, to wit:

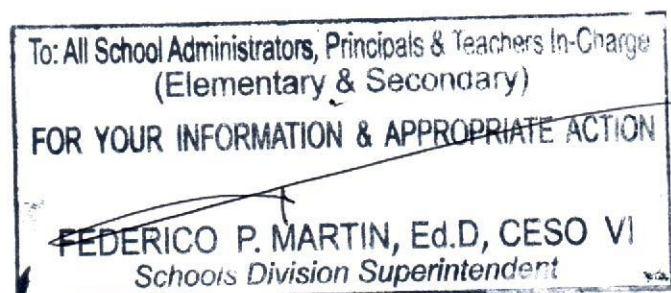
1. City officials and employees are directed to render community service (clean up drive) activity in the central business district of the City of Baguio;

3. Administrative Officers or Personnel-In-Charge will check the attendance of employees who will participate to the said activity.

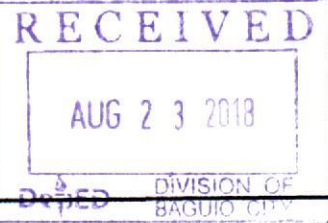
This order is issued in the interest of public service and shall take effect on 28 September 2018, from 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.

### **DECLARING FRIDAY, 21 SEPTEMBER 2018, 8:00 AM TO 12:00 NOON, AS MASSIVE CLEAN UP DRIVE AT BALILI RIVER IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO**

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 131, series of 2010 "Declared every fourth Friday of every month as Citywide Clean Up Day in the City of Baguio" and Administrative Order No. 108, series of 2016 "Declaring Friday, 23 September 2016, 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon, as Clean up Activity at City Market, Central Business District and Environs".

**WHEREAS**, there is a City Ordinance penalizing the dumping of garbage into the city's creeks and river tributaries but much work is yet to be done in terms of its implementation.

**WHEREAS**, the headwater of Balili River is Sagudin River and is found in Trancoville Barangay in Baguio City. Sagudin River is sustained by tributary creeks coming from Pacdal, Cabinet Hill, New Lucban, Honeymoon, Guisad and Sto. Nino (formerly Slaughter Compound) barangays.

**WHEREAS**, dumping of litters, sewage and other domestic and human refuse into the creeks and tributaries of the Balili River continue to be unabated.

**WHEREAS**, the Balili River continue to be polluted because of these wastes. Aside from being eyesores, the garbage clog the waterways.

**WHEREAS**, the officials and employees shall take the lead for effective solid and wastewater management through a massive community clean-up drive to clean the creeks and tributaries heading the Balili River, to bring back its cleanliness.

**WHEREAS**, all city officials and employees and adjacent/surroundings barangays are mandated to participate in the massive clean-up drive on 21 September 2018 at 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon. Departments/offices shall assign skeletal force in their respective offices so as not to jeopardize the delivery of basic services. Administrative Officers/Personnel-In-Charge shall check the attendance of employees who will participate to the said activity.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, MAURICIO G. DOMOGAN**, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Friday, 21 September 2018, 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon as Clean-up Drive of the City Government of Baguio officials and employees for purposes of contributing cleanliness and intensify the peoples' awareness of their role and responsibilities as stakeholders of an effective and efficient solid and waste water management.

All previous executive issuance and orders inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed modified or amended accordingly.
