**2018 SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING SCOUTMASTERS**

1. We are pleased to announce the Search for the Outstanding Scoutmasters for 2018. The search is open to all Unit Leaders. The word Scoutmaster is used as a generic term for all Unit Leaders in the different Scouting Sections of the BSP.
2. The objective of this project is to recognize the outstanding achievements of Unit Leaders in the development of the youth in the city.
3. The selection will be at the Institutional, District and Council levels. All Schools/Districts are therefore encouraged to send their nominees for screening at the District level. A Council Selection Committee will be constituted to make the final screening and selection based on the nominations coming from the different districts. District Offices are requested to submit their nominations at the BSP Council Office on or before September 14, 2018 based on the following quota:

  - 12 October 2018 - Deadline for submission of nominations from the District/Municipal Scouting Committee to the Council Office.
  - 26 October 2018 - Council Level Screening and Selection.
  - 09 November 2018 - Awarding Ceremony during the Council Court of Honor

7. A cash prize and plaques of recognition will be awarded to the winners.
