- 3. Likewise, each district will have only one (1) entry in the division level (except for Quiz Bee), hence, different districts are encouraged to conduct an elimination or pre-qualifying round for both public and private schools prior to the division level.
- 4. Registration is free and cash prizes, including certificates will also be awarded to the division winners. Kindly refer to the enclosure for various contest mechanics.
- 5. Please be guided accordingly. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

GUIDELINES FOR THE QUIZ BEE

- 1. The coverage of the quiz is about the City of Baguio.
- 2. The participants are Grade 3 pupils coming from public or private schools. Two teams per district. (Each team composed of two pupils)
- 3. During the quiz, participants will be provided with writing materials.
- 4. English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
- 5. Participants will be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy", seven (7) are "average" and seven (7) are difficult.
- 6. Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:
 - One (1) point for each "easy" question
 - Two (2) points for each "average" question
 - Three (3) points for each "difficult" question
- 7. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question.
- 8. The quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
- 9. Top three (3) teams will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring. The winning teams will be receiving cash prizes.
- 10. All ties shall be broken by a tie breaker question from the "difficult" category.
- 11. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:
- -Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
- -The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges who will recognize then protest or inquiry.
- -The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.

Junior High School (Pair) CONTEST MECHANICS/GUIDELINES

Entry Details

- a. Each district will come up with only one (1) entry or pair preferably from Grade 10 (1 to layout pictures or photographs and 1 to write an essay) and one (1) coach. There will be a total of four (4) pairs competing for the division level.
- b. Materials will be provided per team (1 whole size illustration board, marker/pen, glue and bond paper). However, participants are allowed to bring other things, aside from pictures, such as colored paper, scotch/masking tape etc. if necessary.
- c. Maximize the use of the illustration board for the layout of pictures and the written essay. English will be utilized for the captions and essay. The photo essay must also reflect the theme.
- d. The duration of the said contest is two (2) hours (1 hour for layout and captioning of pictures, 1 hour for essay writing); hence entries must be finished or completed within the allotted time.

Steps/Procedure

A photo essay is a combination of art and journalism with the elements structured in a way that easily conveys a story. Thus, the photo essay must reflect the theme: "Celebrating and Moving Beyond 109 through Culture of Creativity". It should develop a narrative that paints a picture of the memories and experiences about Baguio City.

- 1. Participants (pairs) should select beforehand five (5) photographs or images related to the theme, printed in A4/short photo paper/board paper to be brought in the contest. The contest photos maybe original or borrowed. If borrowed or copied from the Internet, cite or acknowledge the source or reference by providing the name of photographer or web address.
- 2. During the contest proper, one member of the pair would display or layout the 5 chosen photos (portrait or landscape) on the illustration board as artistically or creatively as possible. Below each photo, write one-sentence caption which should explain the said photo and relate to the essay's theme.
- 3. At the same time, the remaining member would be writing a three-paragraph essay on a bond paper regarding the concept of the photos and captions in line with the theme. Put an appropriate title afterwards and paste the said essay on the illustration board.

Judging Criteria

- a. The top three will be declared as winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd place). Certificates will also be given to winners and participants, including coaches/teachers who assisted.
- b. Results will be based on the decision of the board of judges and to be announced during the awarding ceremony.

Event Rules and Mechanics

- 1. Bayle is composed of 24 learnerswith 2 coaches open to Secondary Junior and Senior Highincluding ALS from Public and private Schools. Performed in seven (7) minutes including entrance and exit for dance exhibition AND the whole duration of the Street dance parade.
- 2. The "Bayle" is a modern/contemporary street dance skills exhibition anchored on the specific theme. Concept or theme for performance, costume, and props must be reflective and relevant to their locality but not limited to the festivals.
- 3. The "Bayle" shall have two (2) separate competitions:
 - a. Modern Street Dance Parade—It is the choreographed parade routine performed by each group as they travel from one judging area to the next during the Festival Parade.
 - b. Dance Exhibition It is the full presentation of the group's dance performance.
- 4. The Division shall combine the results of the street and the dance exhibition competition to determine the division entry to the Regional Level.
- 5. A maximum of 24 parade dancers and 2 coaches will be allowed to per contingent.
- 6. The step in Street dance competition should be progressive in nature.
- 7. The group may use any music of their choice during the dance exhibition, but the dance routines should be purely transformational in nature which is characterized by the used of the danced steps and movements which could be a fusion of two or more dance forms such as classical ballet contemporary/ modern dance, jazz, hip-hop, folkloric, neoethnic and other genre.
- 8. The following are strictly prohibited during the performances:
 - Tossing
 - Lifting
 - · Use of flammable materials such as fireworks or pyro techniques
 - · Live animals as part of the performance
 - Individual props that exceeds 3 feet in height/diameter, except cloth
 - Provision for pre-set stage .

A 3-point deduction from the judge's score shall be made per violation incurred.

- 9. An assigned committee composed of the 3 TWG shall be in- charge of the inspection of the materials, props, etc. prior to the competition to ensure compliance as mentioned.
- 10. Costumes and props are encouraged.
- 11. Only hand-held props shall be allowed to be used in the parade and exhibition.
- 12 Each contingent will provide their own mobile sound system.
- 13. Each group will be judged during the parade and at the exhibition venue.
- 14. One (1) point deduction from each from each judge's total score shall be deducted for every 30 second extension beyond the allowable time.
