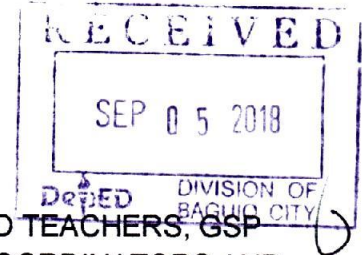

RE : **GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT 2018**

Following the success of the Girl Scouts Got Talent 2017, the National Headquarters is happy to announce that another " **Girl Scouts Got TALENT** " will be held on **Friday, October 12, 2018 from 1:00 p.m. to 5 p.m. at the Pilar Hidalgo Lim Auditorium, GSP National Headquarters, Padre Faura Street, Ermita, Manila.**

It aims to showcase the different modes of talent of our Girl Scouts in singing, dancing, playing a musical instrument, and others that will promote girl empowerment. It is also a venue to express their creativity, show off their skills, and build their confidence and character.

Girl Scouts Got Talent is also in celebration of the International Day of the Girl that is observed on October 11 each year since its launching and declaration in 2012 by the United Nations.

Please be reminded that **it is not a completion, but rather a showcase of flair** where three (3) best performers will be selected to render intermission numbers during the Chief Girl Scout Medal Presentation Ceremony on Friday, November 23, 2018 at the Plenary Hall of the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Pasay City.

In this regard, we invite all the Troop Leaders to encourage their girls to participate.

### **The rules and regulations are:**

1. It is open to all registered Five- Level Girl Scouts. Performers can sign up for solo, pair, or group acts. Groups can only have a maximum number of eight (8) members.
2. Each Region can only have a maximum of five (5) solo or group performers. Each Council is allowed to have one (1) performance only.
3. Acts will be allotted at least 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes to perform.
4. Presentation should be wholesome and entertaining (**STRICTLY no negative, no cross – dressing, no gay roles, e.g. making fun of disabilities/ sexually suggestive actions, etc.**).
5. Acts requiring more than 12 feet of ceiling height will not be allowed.
6. **NO** profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music.
7. Costumes, props, and musical accompaniment may be used to enhance the performance.

8. **NO** nudity allowed! Keep attire at a respectable and tasteful level. **NO** alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements are to be shown on any clothing.
9. **NO** pyrotechnics, open flames, or any other dangerous additions.
10. A sound technician and microphone(s) will be provided.
11. Performers **MUST** provide their own recorded music, instruments, props, etc., if needed.
12. Recorded music must be on a CD or USB flash drive in an acceptable format (i.e. MP3 file) to be submitted to National Headquarters on or before **September 24, 2018**.
13. The **Technical and Dress Rehearsal** of all the performers is on **October 12, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. only**.
14. Lunch and afternoon snacks will be provided to all performers and to their respective coaches/Troop Leaders on October 12. Lunch will served at 11:00 a.m. at Josefa Llanes Escoda Hall and afternoon snacks will be distributed after the event.
15. Badges and Certificates of recognition will be awarded to the performers and their coaches/ Troop leaders.
16. **It is a showcase of talent NOT a competition.**
17. From the performers, three (3) performing numbers will be selected to perform during the Chief Girl Scout Medal Presentation Ceremony on Friday, November 23, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. at the Plenary Hall of the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Pasay City.
18. Participation of Troop/girls must confirm their participation by submitting the accomplished registration form to their respective region on or before **September 14, 2018**. This is on a first come first serve d basis. (Attached is the registration form.)
