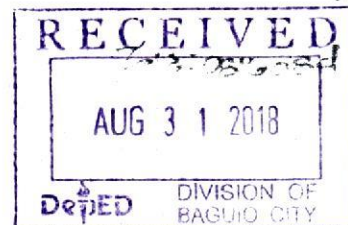


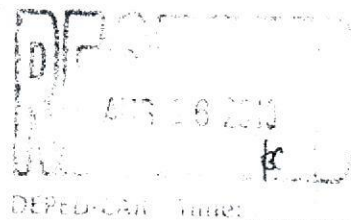

**RESOLUTION Numbered 236
(Series of 2018)**

REQUESTING THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OF BAGUIO CITY, DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION-CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION (DepEd-CAR) TO MONITOR THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF DepEd ORDER NO. 13, S. 2017 [POLICY AND GUIDELINES ON HEALTHY FOOD AND BEVERAGE CHOICES IN SCHOOLS AND IN DEPED OFFICES] AND TO ENCOURAGE FOOD STORES WITHIN THE PROXIMITY OF SCHOOLS TO ADOPT THE SAID DepEd ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education issued on 14 March 2017 DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017 [POLICY AND GUIDELINES ON HEALTHY FOOD AND BEVERAGE CHOICES IN SCHOOLS AND IN DEPED OFFICES] for the promotion and development of healthy eating habits among the youth and DepEd employees by making available healthy, nutritious and affordable menu choices, and for setting food standards and further to address the nutrition problem/issues of children while studying in schools;

WHEREAS, the said Policy and Guidelines applies to all public elementary and secondary schools, learning centers, including DepEd offices in central, regional, and division levels, private schools are likewise enjoined to adopt the Order;

WHEREAS, Senior Citizen Official For-A-Day (SOFAD) Councilor Erlinda J. Bueno during the Senior Citizen Official For-A-Day Session of 02 October 2017 introduced a proposed Resolution entitled, "Addressing the Deped to strictly monitor and implement Memorandum Circular No. 17, Series of 2017 entitled, 'Policy and Guidelines on Healthy Food and Beverage Choices in Schools and in Deped Offices' in school canteens and encourage stores within the proximity of schools to follow";

WHEREAS, various studies conducted both local and foreign have addressed the fact that poor nutrition contributes to the poor performance and well-being of children thereby affecting their learning and development. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), malnutrition in all its forms presents a significant threat to human health. WHO confirmed the Double Burden of Malnutrition [DBM] the world is facing today, especially in developing countries like the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, it has been observed that some schools in the city are already adhering to the said Order, however there are schools who continue to sell non-nutritious food and drinks to school children thus the problem on nutrition still persists. While food stores located outside of the schools are strongly encourage to follow by selling healthier products especially to children to aid the efforts of the DepEd in curbing the nutrition problems among school children:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Schools Division of Baguio City, Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd-CAR) to monitor the strict implementation of DepEd Order No. 13, S. 2017 [POLICY AND GUIDELINES ON HEALTHY FOOD AND BEVERAGE CHOICES IN SCHOOLS AND IN DEPED OFFICES] and to encourage food stores within the proximity of schools to adopt the said DepEd Order.
