## WEST BAGUIO CENTRAL AND BAGUIO CENTRAL DISTRICT (SECONDARY)

### RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE 2018 DISTRICT FUTSAL

Date: **September 26-28, 2018**

Venue: **To be announced**

- 1. Number of players**  
5 players including the goal keeper per team shall play against the other team during the game with 7 substitute players on the bench.
- 2. Offside Rule**  
No offside rule
- 3. Rotating Substitutions**  
Up to 12 players can be used in a match and there is no limit on how long a player can stay on the pitch, nor is a stoppage required for player's substitutions. Players substituting must enter and leave the field from the side line right after the substituted player/s is/are out of the pitch.
- 4. Kick-Ins**  
The ball must be placed stationary on the line and the feet of the player taking the kick-in must not cross the line.
- 5. The 4 Second Rule**  
For kick-ins, goal clearances and corner kicks, the player in possession of the ball has 4 seconds to restart play which the referee will count with fingers in the air. If play is not restarted within 4 seconds ball possession will be awarded to the opposing team.
- 6. The 6 Feet Rule**  
Players are required to keep 6 feet from the player in possession of the ball during kick-ins, goal clearances and corner kicks
- 7. Goalkeepers**
  - a. Goalkeepers are allowed to come out of the penalty area, however she is not allowed to use her hand to play unless within the penalty arc.
  - b. A goal clearance must be thrown (and not kicked).
  - c. The goalkeeper cannot touch the ball again until it has crossed midfield or a member of the opposing team has touched the ball.
  - d. Ball clearance received before the midline is a violation in the tournament.
- 8. Accumulated Fouls**  
On the 6<sup>th</sup> foul a penalty kick is awarded to the opposing team. The kick may be taken from second penalty mark.
- 9. Game Time**  
A match will consist of 40 minutes (20 minutes per half) with 5 minutes half time break. Clock will only stop during time out s and haft time break.
- 10. Time Outs**  
Each team is allowed one 30-second time out per half of the game.
- 11. Sliding Tackling**  
Sliding tackles are not allowed but referees will not give a foul for a slide if the opponent does not have possession of the ball.

**13. Tournament Standings will be based on the following:**

- Win 3 points
- Draw 1 point
- Loss 0 point

**14.** The most number of points shall be declared as the winner of the tournament.

**15.** In the event of a two-way tie between teams:

- a. The fewest goals against will determine the prevailing team.
- b. If the teams are still tied, the most goals for will determine the prevailing team.
- c. If the teams are still tied, a coin flip will determine the prevailing team.

**16.** In the event of a tie between 3 or more teams:

The order of finish will be based on best record involving games between the tied teams

- a. If the teams are still tied (or an unequal number of games were played against each other), the order of finish will be based on fewest goals against
- b. If the teams are still tied, the order of finish will be based on most goals for
- c. If the teams are still tied, the order of finish will be drawn from a hat

**17. Selection of Players**

- a. Selection of player/s will be done right after the tournament.
- b. 12 players shall be selected from the participating teams based from the individual athletic performance of the athlete/s during the entire duration of the tournament for the benefit of the district and not solely of the winner school.
- c. No other official/s will dictate or suggest in the selection of player/s to represent West Baguio and Baguio Central District for the Palarong Panlungsod 2017 except the Tournament Manager and the official coach per team present during the entire course of the tournament.


**18. Selection of coaching Staff/s**

- a. Champion school shall become the head coach of the team to represent the district in the palorong panlungsod 2<sup>nd</sup> placer the assistant coach and third placer will be the trainer. However, if the coach is not available, he/she shall pass the position to the second placer coach; if the second coach is also not available he/she shall pass the responsibility to the third placer coach as agreed upon during the district meeting last September 2017.
- b. No other teacher/coach or school official shall take over the position of the head coach in his/her absence to allow personal growth and development among the legitimate futsal coaches present during the tournament.
- c. The coach/coaching staff/s are therefore encouraged to support the team during the training to prepare the players prior to the Palarong Panlungsod on October 2018. Failure to do so will be a subject of discussion on next year's district sports meet.

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
