



61st JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) AND 22nd JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the **61st Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA)** and the **22nd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)** on October 20 - 21, 2018 at Baguio City National High School, Gov. Pack Road, Baguio City.
2. The JOTA and JOTI is an annual event of the World Organization of Scout Movement (WOSM) which Scouts and Guides all over the world make contacts with each other by means of amateur radio and using internet techniques to make friends, exchange stories and experience different cultures. The activity also gives an awareness that Scouts belong to a worldwide Movement.
3. This scouting event will also be a good opportunity to enhance learning through the different activities and experience Scout brotherhood.
4. Other details of the activity are:
 - a. Eight (8) per school (Boy Scout/Senior Scout/Rover Roverette)
 - b. A registration fee of **Fifty Pesos (Php 50.00)** shall be charged each participant to cover cost of program materials and other administrative requirements.
 - c. Participants who wish to stay overnight are advised to bring **PACKED DINNER & BREAKFAST** on **October 20, 2018** and **October 21, 2018** respectively.

**SUBJECT : 61st JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) and
22nd JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)**

1. The 61st Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 22nd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) will be held on third weekend of October 19-21, 2018 at BSP National Office, 181 Natividad Almeda-Lopez St., Ermita, Manila with a satellite located at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC). The traditional timeframe is Saturday 00:00H until Sunday 24:00H local time. Each station can choose its own operating hours, including beginning on Friday at 00:00H, based on their local telecommunications regulations and authorization, as well as station and Scout availability.
2. The Official Amateur Radio Club of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is **DX1 BSP** per approved National Executive Board Resolution No. 53-2017, Series of 2017. DX1 BSP will be the one responsible for the conduct of the JOTA,
3. The theme of the event will be **"Life on Land — United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 15"**. The theme encourages reaching out to Scouts and Guides all over the world and engage in conversations with each other by means of amateur radio and the Internet in Scouting programs
4. Hereunder is pertinent information of this event
61st Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA)

Guidelines for Participation:

- a. All stations must operate strictly in accordance with the Philippine Amateur Radio regulations.
- b. Call "CQ Jamboree" or answer any station that you may hear using this call.
- c. When you call or search for station/s, use any of the following frequencies:

New World Scout Frequencies

- d. As in previous years, solicit the early assistance/support of the Amateur Radio Organizations/Associations in your locality.

22nd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)

How to organize a Council JOTI Station:

- a. Local Councils should create a JOTI Station and select a Coordinator. The station shall be called "(Name of Council) JOTI Station," example: *Manila Council Internet Team*
 - b. The Coordinator and the members of the group should have the following:
 - Knowledgeable on computer hardware and software specially in the use of Internet Browser (Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator) and Chatting (mIRC or vIRC)
 - Must have a personal computer
 - Must have an access to the Internet that can be used for the JOTI.
 - Must have an e-mail address
 - c. It is suggested that at least one (1) group/patrol/crew and one (1) trained Adult Leader be designated to operate a JOTI station.
 - d. As soon as the Council JOTI station has been established, please submit to National Office, BSP the following information thru e-mail: bsp@scouts.org.ph
 - Local Council JOTI station Coordinator
 - Members of the group
 - Homepage or web site address
 - E-mail addresses of the members
 - List of Group/Troop/Patrol/Institutional JOTI station with e-mail address
 - Other Scouting activities simultaneous with event
 - e. You can download and print the standard guidelines from www.world-jota-joti.info and send your technical inquiries at bsp@scouts.org.ph
5. It is suggested that Local Councils should conduct simultaneous Scout Activities (Camping, Forum, Betterworld programs, Solar Energy, etc.) during the 61st Jamboree-On-The-Air and 22nd Jamboree-On-The-Internet to enable the Scouts to earn additional Merit Badges.
 6. Please send Post-Activity pictorial report to the National Office on or before 15 November 2017, to form part of the JOTA/JOTI-After Action Report and 2019 Annual Report and @ boyet.francia@scouts.org.ph.
