RE : **INTERNATIONAL PEACE POSTER CONTEST AND ESSAY
WRITING CONTEST**

The Lions Club international is inviting again the Girl Scouts of the Philippines to participate in the upcoming **2018 Lions International peace Poster Contest and Essay Writing Contest** with the theme "**Kindness Matters**". The Contest promotes a wonderful opportunity for our girls to express themselves about peace, sharing their own interpretation of it and empower young girls on tolerance and international understanding.

The contest encourages Junior and Senior Girl Scouts who are ages of 11, 12, or 13. They can send entry for one (1) category only. Below are the guidelines and contest rule.

I. Guidelines for Peace Poster Contest

- a. Qualified to participate are Junior and Senior Girl Scouts ages 11, 12 or 13 on November 15, 2018. Eligible birth dates are November 16, 2004 to November 15, 2007.
- b. Artwork must be no smaller than 13 in. x 20 in. (33 cm x 50 cm) and no larger than 20 in. x 24 in. (50 cm x 60 cm). Do not mat or frame artwork.
- c. Only one (1) entry per Girl Scout and each entry must be the work of only one (1) Girl Scout contestant.
- d. All artwork must be the individual's original creation. Duplications are not accepted.
- e. All kinds of medium are accepted. Note: Chalk, charcoal and pastel entries should be sealed with a fixative spray to prevent smearing. Do not laminate entries.
- f. Three-dimensional entries will not be accepted. Nothing may be glued, stapled or attached to the artwork in any way.
- g. The use of lettering or numbering on the front of the poster, in any language, is not allowed. All artist signatures or initials should be written at the back of the poster.
- h. Artwork should be done on a flexible material, which can be easily rolled for shipping purposes. Do not fold poster.
- i. Deadline of all entries must be submitted and received by the GSP Baguio City Council Headquarters Leonard Wood Road, Baguio City on or before October 20, 2018. There will be no extension for submission of entries. Late entries will not be included in the judging process.

J. Guidelines for Peace Essay Writing Contest

- a. The contest is open for Junior and Senior Girl Scouts ages 11, 12 or 13 on November 15, 2018. Eligible birth dates are November 16, 2004 to November 15, 2007.
- b. Essays must be no longer than 500 words in length, submitted in English, type-written in black ink and double-spaced.
- c. Each essay must be submitted with a complete entry form. Essays submitted with incomplete entry forms will be automatically disqualified.
- d. Only one (1) entry per student per year, and each entry must be the work of only one student.
- e. Essay entries must not have been published.
- f. Any essays found to be plagiarized will be automatically disqualified and the student will be prohibited from entering any future Lions competitions.
- g. Deadline of all entries must be submitted and received by the GSP Baguio City Council Headquarters Leonard Wood Road, Baguio City on or before October 20, 2018. There will be no extension for submission of entries. Late entries will not be included in the judging process.
