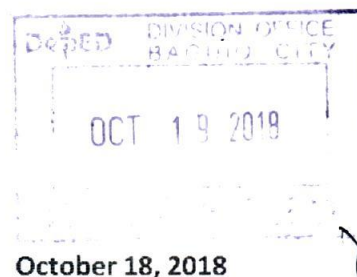

1. This year, the Department of Education Central Office has downloaded funds for the Search for Outstanding Implementers at the Regional Level to give recognition to the best implementers of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program. Cash Incentives, plaques of recognition and certificates will be given to the winning schools.
2. The Search is open to all public elementary and secondary schools in the Cordillera Administrative Region.
3. There will be two categories –Elementary and Secondary Schools.
4. In this regard, interested schools are advised to submit School Garden Reports for the last two years – SY 2017 -2018 and SY 2018 -2019 with appropriate documentations for the School Division GPP Coordinator and School Health Section Coordinators to screen and evaluate.
5. Entry shall be submitted at the SGOD School Health Section Division Office c/o Dr. Jocelyn De Jesus on or before October 24, 2018.
6. Selected entry/ entries shall then be submitted to the Regional Office on or before October 31, 2018 for evaluation which shall start on November 2018.
7. Attached is the criteria for judging and entry form.
