RE : LOGO- MAKING CONTEST FOR THE 41st GSP NATIONAL
CAMP

We are pleased to inform you that the Girl Scouts of the Philippines will hold its **Camp Logo- Making Contest** with the theme "**BE PREPARED : Girl Scouts in Action**". This is in line with the upcoming 41st GSP National Camp on December 1-6, 2018 at Gabriela Silang Girl Scout Camp, Banaoang, Bantay, Ilocos Sur.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

The contest is open to all registered Senior/ CADET Girl Scouts as of December 2018 with the following qualifications:

1. Must be physically fit and alert.
2. Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge.
3. Must have attended a troop/ patrol/ council/ regional camp prior to this camp.
4. Must be a Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course Certificate Holder or has attended the Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course.

GUIDELINES

1. Only one (1) entry per Girl Scout allowed ; and each entry must be the work of only one (1) Girl Scout contestant.
2. Submission must be accompanied with the Girl Scout contestant's basic information:
 - NAME
 - COUNCIL
 - REGION
 - ADDRESS
 - EMAIL ADDRESS
 - CONTACT NUMBER
3. The design of the logo should be versatile in its application and must embody the essence of the camp theme "**BE PREPARED: Girl Scouts in Action**." It should communicate the GSP's motto and its vision "**Girls and young women who are progressive, dynamic, proactive, patriotic, and God-loving.**"
4. The logo design must be the Girl Scout's original creation. Duplications are not accepted.
5. By participating in the contest, the Girl Scout contestant declares that the logo submitted is her original work, have not been submitted to any other contest, and does not infringe on any third party's existing copyrights. Any complaints that may arise due to similarities, likeness or comparison of the design would be the accountability of the Girls Scout contestant as she would be responsible to prove its authenticity.
6. The size of the logo entry should not be smaller than 6' x 6' inches. There are no restrictions in the number of colors used.
7. All kinds of medium are accepted including graphic arts and other digital layouts.
8. Use of lettering or numbering on the design or layout is permitted.
9. All entries must come with a brief description of the logo along with the fully accomplished application form. This should not be more than 500 words.

10. The logo design should not reflect or show any mark, initials, and words, phrases that identifies the Girl Scout artist.

11. The logo entries may be submitted by sending the actual drawings or designs or by scanning in high resolution digital file of the entry. (JPEG, PNG, PDF)

Note: Please use a flexible material, which can be easily rolled for shipping purposes, seal your artwork with a fixative spray to prevent smearing.

12. Deadline of all entries must be submitted and received by the GSP Baguio Council with mailing address at Leonard Wood Road, Baguio City or email at gsp_2096@yahoo.com.ph on or before October 27, 2018. There will be no extension for submission of entries. Late entries will not be included in the judging process.

13. The logo-making contest shall be judged by the GSP National Program Committee based on the following criteria:

- Concept/ Relevance -40%
- Originality-30%
- Creativity and Impact- 30%

14. The winning entry will be announced on November 12, 2018, Monday through the GSP official Facebook account. The winner shall be informed through the GSP Regional Office, Girl Scout Council, email and telephone call.

15. The decision of the committee is final. No correspondence pertaining to these decisions shall be entertained.

16. The GSP National Headquarters reserves the right to further refine or make improvements and alterations on the final artwork of the winning entry.

AWARDS

1. All Girl Scout contestants' who submitted entries on or before October 27, 2018 will be awarded a badge under the Challenge of Arts; and the International Day of the Girl 2018" Team Girl" badge.

2. The winning entry shall be the official logo of the 41st GSP National Camp and will be used in all camp items including the camp badge.

3. The winner will attend as camper to the 41st GSP National Camp at Gabriela Silang Girl Scout Camp, Banaoang, Bantay, Ilocos Sur on December 1-6, 2018.

4. Awarding of the entry shall be on December 2, 2018, Sunday-in time for the Opening Ceremony of the 41st GSP National Camp.

5. All entries submitted as entry for the contest shall be considered as property of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines , and maybe used by the GSP at any time that its sees fit, such as but not limited to publications, advertisements, exhibits and other printed or digital media.
