The Public Management Development Program (PMDP), the National Government's Career Executive Service Development Program is now accepting nominations for its Senior Executive Class (SEC) in a non-residential/live-out 'shuttle format'.

The PMDP-SEC seeks to produce a critical mass of peak-performing, development-oriented, ethical and committed government executives in the Philippine bureaucracy. SEC is designed for officials holding permanent Directorship positions including Assistant Directors or their equivalents, with SG 25 and above, aged 55 years old or younger, and in good health. OICs of third level positions are also eligible.

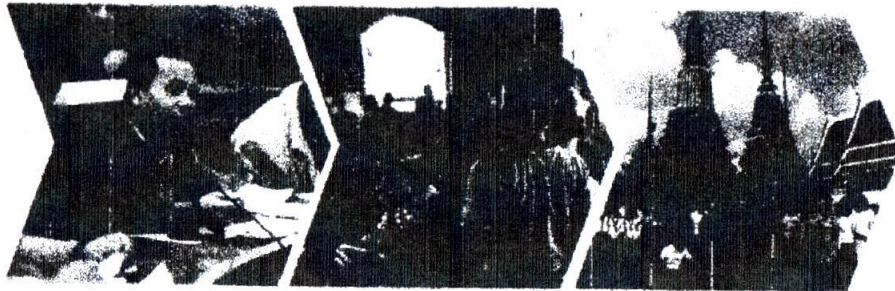

### THE QUALIFICATIONS

The PMDP Senior Executives Class is designed for senior officials who possess outstanding intellectual and creative abilities, show deep commitment to public service, and demonstrate potential for shaping policy and management at higher levels of government. Candidates shall be from the pool of incumbents or OICs of permanent positions with salary grade 25 or higher and 58 years old or less who are in good health. **Candidates must commit to complete the program in one year.**
