Existing records holdings which have been built up over years and decades may have no documentation associated with them, or have different levels of quality of documentation. Examining the existing documentation, one can come to realize that different departments, or areas, of the organization called the same records by different names. There are also instances that the description of the records prepared by the same person may actually change over the years.

When we talk, we speak in "natural language." The most effective communication occurs when all parties involved agree on the meaning of the terms being used. But when we organize our information and label it, this natural language has so much variability that makes it difficult to find information that we know exists. Therefore, it is of prime importance to use a controlled vocabulary that ensures everyone is using the same word to mean the same thing. It imposes some order to ease the finding of the stored information and reduces the duplication of effort that arises because existing information cannot be found since they were labeled differently.
