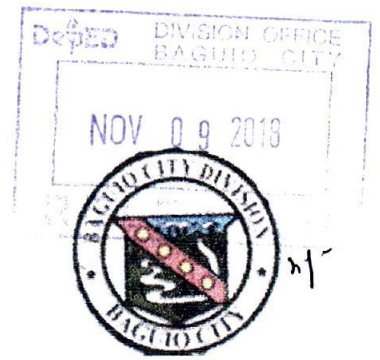

4. Please submit the name, age, school, address, and name of contact person and their contact number, to the School Health and Nutrition Section Office through Dr. Jocelyn M. de Jesus. You may email the names of the children and students at librabb163@gmail.com or at jocelyn_djesus@yahoo.com.
5. Personnel who have hearing abnormalities are also encourage to avail of the opportunity to be screened and tested to confirm their defects. This will enhance their teaching performance just in case the defects will be resolved.
6. Hearing Aids will be given to all beneficiaries with lifetime maintenance of the gadget and regular free follow-up by locally trained nurses and doctors by the Foundation.
