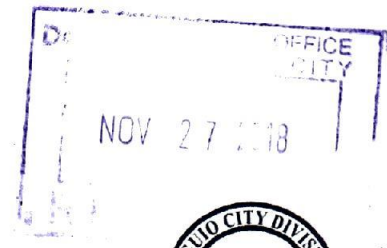

REGIONAL TRAINING ON PRIMALS FOR GRADES IV TO VI TEACHERS

To: **Education Program Supervisors

1. In relation to DepEd Regional Memorandum no. 349, series of 2018, the **Regionwide Training on Pedagogical Retooling in Mathematics, Languages and Science (PRIMALS) will be conducted on December 10-14, 2018 at Highlander Hotel-National Highway Roxas, Solano, Nueva Vizcaya.**
2. Specifically, this training aims to enhance the reading and literacy skills of Grades 4 to 6 learners in English and Filipino, likewise with other content areas such as Mathematics and Science following the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum by establishing a sustainable and cost effective professional development component of the said program.
3. Hence, enclosed is the list of participants from the Baguio City Division who are untrained teachers in PRIMALS. Attendance is highly expected from participants because they will be obliged to pay the amount allotted to each if they fail to attend the said training.
4. Meals for 5 days will be charged to PRIMALS (Grades 4-6) fund. First meal is dinner on December 9 and last meal is afternoon snacks on December 14. Accommodation and lodging will be coordinated by SDO Ifugao. Travel expenses and other meals not covered within the training will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Reminders include the following:

- a. Participants should not be nursing mothers and bringing of kids is not allowed;
 - b. Participants are requested to bring laptops, extension cords and pocket WIFI, and
 - c. School heads/Teachers are encouraged to take appropriate actions to avoid disruption of classes.
6. Kindly refer also to the attached regional memo for additional details.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

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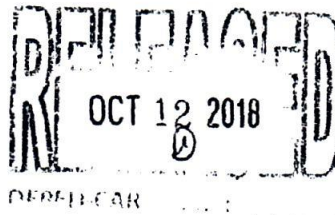

LANGUAGES, AND SCIENCE (PRIMALS, GRADES 4 – 6)**

1. With reference to DepEd Memorandum-CI-2017-0017 entitled Pedagogical Retooling in Mathematics, Languages, and Science for Grades 4 to 6 (PRIMALS, Gr 4-6) and to ensure the continuity of the implementation of DepEd Order No. 12, s.2015 on Early Language Literacy and Numeracy, DepEd-CAR through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the Regionwide training on **December 10-14, 2018** at a venue to be announced soon through (SMS) text message.
