- j. Failure on the part of the bidders to comply with the foregoing instructions or additional requirements shall be a ground for the bidder to be disqualified to join the bidding process.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 011 s. 2018 shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents.


