

BIBLE QUIZ CRITERIA

January 31, 2019
Division of City Schools Training Center
Military Cut-off Road, Baguio City

RATIONALE:

Presidential Proclamation Nos. 44, s. of 1986 and 1067, s. 1997, declares every last week of January of every year as National Bible Week. Presidential Proclamation No. 124, s. 2017, recognizes the religious nature of the Filipino people and declaring the whole Month of January of every year as National Bible Month culminating in the last week of January as the National Bible Week. Certain activities pursued in the exercise of religious freedom contribute to the attainment of this goal are received, encouraged and supported by the government.

Baguio City Council Resolution No. 173 s. 2008 entitled "Declaring the 4th Week of January and every Year thereafter as National Bible week in the City of Baguio" states that the Baguio Character Council, in coordination with the faith community and the Philippine Bible Society will lead and to formulate the necessary activities of the National Bible Week Celebration and one of the activities is the conduct of a Bible Quiz Competition.

PURPOSE:

It is a fun way to motivate individuals to study God's Word and meditate on the scriptures through a healthy competition. It aims to develop Bible reading to raise awareness of Biblical truth among the citizenry and strengthen the conviction that God's word is the basic foundation of a happy and peaceful life.

DESCRIPTION:

The Bible Quiz Bee shall test the learner's knowledge and understanding on the practices and belief that promote peace by answering questions derived from the Bible


OBJECTIVES:

The Bible Quiz Bee aims to showcase learner's skills on the following:

- 1. Mastery level on the content of the Bible; and,
- 2. Display the value of unity and sportsmanship among the participants.

SOURCE TEXT:

Coverage of the Bible Quiz questions will be from Genesis to Revelations. All questions will be in English using the New King James Version or the New English Version.



MECHANICS:

- ➤ There shall be three (3) per team participants, coming from the Intermediate category (Grades 4 to 6) and Junior High School Category (Grades 7 to 10), both from Public and Private Schools.
- > The officials are the Quizmaster, Timekeeper, Proctor and Three (3) judges
- > The quiz will be done on a single round consisting of Thirty (30) questions at one (1) point each. All questions will be multiple choice in nature.
- ➤ Each of the question shall be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "GO". The team then will write their answers within Ten (10) seconds for the easy and average rounds and Twenty (20) seconds for difficult round.
- When the time is up, the timekeeper rings the bell/buzzer. The team shall stop answering and show their answers to the proctors by raising the boards/meta cards
- The proctor will read the answer of each team and record in the tally board and tally sheet
- After each round, points will be tabulated. The final scores will be tabulated after the difficult round.
- ➤ The Three (3) teams with the highest points win and be declared as the first, second, third, fourth and fifth place respectively. Non-winning teams will received consolation prizes.
- In case of tie, a clincher round shall be given. The first one to give the correct answer shall be the winner. If no team is able to give the correct answer, another clincher question shall be given until a winner comes up.

SUBSTITUTION:

No substitution will be allowed once the match has commenced.

QUIZ OFFICIALS:

The competition officials will be as follows:

1. Quizmaster

The quizmaster is responsible for governing all aspects of the quiz.

- a. Must know and understand all the rules thoroughly
- b. Must be familiar with the portion of Scripture being studied/ask

- c. Check all questions before each quiz for accuracy and proper construction
- d. Instruct the timekeeper to start and stop the clock
- e. Read all questions at the same rate of speed
- f. Render decisions firmly and consistently
- g. Responsible for calling fouls
- h. Maintain positive attitude toward the guizzers
- i. Determine whether an answer is correct or not
- j. Ensures that each quiz stays on schedule and finishes on time
- k. Remember the importance of edifying both the quizzers and the audience. He or She should speak clearly and enthusiastic about quizzing. To this end, quizzers should be called by name, score should be announced often and quiz outs should be properly recognize

2. Scorekeeper/Proctor

The scorekeeper will maintain the official scoring records for the quiz.

- a. Make appropriate tally marks as the quiz progresses. Indicating errors, fouls, timeouts and correct answers on the official score sheet
- b. Tally and announces the scores at halftime and at the end of the quiz
- c. Notify the quizmaster when a quizzer who will proceed and did not qualify for the next round
- d. Assists the quizmaster in calling fouls and in judging the correctness of answers

3. Timekeeper

The timekeeper will operate the time clock or stopwatch during the quiz

- a. Keep regulation time and will follow the instructions of the quizmaster to time in, time out or restore time
- b. Notify the quizmaster if a quizzer does not begin to answer within 5 seconds of being called upon
- Notify the quizmaster if a quizzer has not finish their answer within the allotted time
- d. Assists the quizmaster in calling fouls and in judging the correctness of answers

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Team members/contestants are requested to take special note of the Code of Conduct. It should be discussed thoroughly with teams, especially as breaches of the Code are grounds for sanction, which may include disqualification.

- ❖ Team members shall be at all times be respectful in their engagement with team mates, opponents and match officials. Display behavior that are unsportsmanlike or go against the grain of team spirit are included under this standards.
- Team members must not curse, swear or use profane or coarse language, inadvertently or not

Competitors are expected to be honest.

PRIZES:

> Prizes will be given to top Three (3) winners and non-winners will received consolation prizes. Trophies will be awarded to the top Three (3) winners for both categories.
