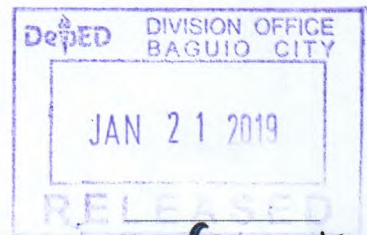



4. The Division Office is tasked to make the transportation arrangement. All participants are expected to be at the venue on January 28, 2019. The host region and the host school's division shall provide meals in the billeting schools, kits, including identification tags, contest materials and other related resources needed in the conduct of the 2019 TECHNOLYMPICS based on budget allocation as mentioned in the DepEd Memo. # 168, s. 2018. The first meal shall be served for lunch on January 28, 2019 while last meal shall be the a.m. snacks on February 1, 2019.
5. All participants especially coaches must refer to DepEd Memo.# 168,s. 2018 and be guided accordingly on the rules and regulations especially on what participants to bring during the contest. Participants are advice to bring sleeping and other basics needs.
