**CONTEST GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS**

6<sup>th</sup> Easter College Academic Olympics

February 8, 2019

*Theme: You shall be my faithful witnesses in the world (adapted from Acts 1:8)*

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**A. General Guidelines:**

1. All participants must be currently enrolled for the school 2018-2019 in any private or public schools in Cordillera Administrative Region.
2. There will be three categories: Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School.
3. A contestant is only allowed to join a single event of the competition.
4. Participating school may field a maximum of two (2) contestants/ groups in any event.
5. A registration fee of Php 75.00 will be charged from each participant to defray expenses relative to the conduct of the activity.
6. All decisions of the Board of Judges and Chairpersons will be final and irrevocable.
7. Determination of over-all winners:
  - First Place* - 20 pts.
  - Second Place* - 15 pts.
  - Third Place* - 10 pts.
  - Participant* - 2 pts.
8. Medal and certificate of recognition will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placers in each event and certificate of participation for all participants. Trophy will be awarded to over-all champion, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up and 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up

**C. Specific Guidelines:**

**1. Quiz Bee**

- a. Each group should compose of three (3) members.
- b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit one (1) identification type question each for Science, Mathematics and Current Events. It should be type/computer written in a one fourth crosswise of a letter size bond paper.
- c. The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed (15 seconds and 45 seconds for questions requiring computations). Answer with incorrect spelling, non observance of capitalization, without units is rendered wrong.
- d. All questions must be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- e. In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.

- g. All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next question; otherwise, it will not be entertained.

**2. Bible Quiz Bee**

- Each group should compose of three (3) members.
- Coaches or contestants are required to submit one (1) identification type question each for people, events and places. It should be type/computer written in a one fourth crosswise of a letter size bond paper.
- The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed. Answer with incorrect spelling and non observances of capitalization are rendered wrong.
- All questions must be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.
- Coverage: Elementary - Four Gospels  
Junior High School - Acts and Epistles  
Senior High School - Pentateuch
- All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next question; otherwise, it will not be entertained.

**3. Spelling Bee**

- Each group should compose of three (3) members.
- Coaches or contestants are required to submit four spelling words (one easy, one average, one difficult, and one clincher), using the Standard English. It should be type/computer written in a one fourth crosswise of a letter size bond paper (8.5 X 13).
- All spelling words should be used in a sentence which shall be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- Time allotment and point per category are as follows:
 

Easy	- 15 seconds	- 1 pt.
Average	- 20 seconds	- 2 pts.
Difficult	- 25 seconds	- 3 pts.
- The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed.
- All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next spelling word.
- In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.

**4. Spoken Word Poetry**

- Open to both junior high and senior high students.
- The spoken word piece to be performed should be 100% original. Each participant should provide 4 photocopies of their spoken word piece on the day of the competition. One copy will be given to the facilitator for plagiarism check and the rest will be given to the judges.
- All pieces must be delivered in English or Filipino as the case maybe.
- Each participant is given a maximum of 4 minutes to deliver the piece. Beyond this limit, 3% will be deducted from the participant's average score.

- e. The participant may deliver the piece with or without a transcript.
- f. While spoken word lends itself to free speech, the use of invectives, curse words, and any sexual innuendos is highly discouraged. Let us maintain a school-friendly atmosphere throughout the competition.
- g. The contest piece must revolve around any of the following themes:
  - for *Junior High School*:
    - ✓ Brave Young Voices
    - ✓ Ang Papel ng Komedyang sa Bagong Lipunan
  - for *Senior High School*:
    - ✓ Resiliency of the Filipino People
    - ✓ Ang Bagong Mukha ng Bayani
- h. The following are the criteria for judging:
 

Content (Imagery, Attitude, and Personality) -	30%
Voice Projection and Expression -	30%
Enunciation -	25%
Facial Expressions and Gestures -	15%
<b>TOTAL</b> -	<b>100%</b>

## 5. Hip-hop Dance

- a. Each group must have eight (8) members.
- b. The dance should not be more than five (5) minutes. Beyond this limit, 3% will be deducted from the group's average score.
- c. The members of the groups maybe composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
- d. Folk dances or accompaniment of folk music is not allowed.
- e. The competition music must not contain inappropriate, lewd or offensive language.
- f. The use of pyrotechnic gadgets, a smoke or combustible material as props is not allowed.
- g. Backdrops, scenery are permitted provided they can be carried on, set up and removed within 10 seconds of being called on to the stage or at the completion of the performance.
- h. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is permitted provided it is not offensive or out of character. Clothing that is too short, suggestive or inappropriate for the age of the performer is not allowed. Tap shoes, jazz shoes, high-heeled shoes and bare feet are prohibited.
- i. The criteria for judging are the following:
 

Choreography (Creativity, Artistry, Style & Originality)	-	50%
Execution (Timing & Coordination, Projection & Expression)	-	30%
Stage deportment/Costume	-	10%
Difficulty of Steps/stunts	-	10%
<b>Total</b>	-	<b>100%</b>
