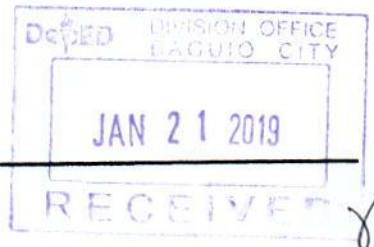

ADMINISTRATIVE 007 series of 2019

SUSPENDING CLASSES IN THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY LEVELS, BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC, ON FRIDAY, 01 FEBRUARY 2019 FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE GRAND OPENING PARADE OF THE 24th EDITION OF "PANAGBENGA" OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BAGUIO FLOWER FESTIVAL

WHEREAS, Section 16 Republic Act (RA) 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, thus necessarily implied therefrom as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, within their respective jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to balance ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant, scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals and enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the 24th edition of "Panagbenga" otherwise known as the Baguio Flower Festival with the theme "Blooming Forward" will be held from February 01 to March 10 2019 where numerous traditional and community-led and government-supported activities will be conducted to boost the City's robust tourism industry;

WHEREAS, the grand opening parade, which will be the elimination round for the participants in the elementary and secondary levels in the City, will be held on Friday, 01 February 2019 to jumpstart the bigger and better activities lined up for the month-long festivities in the City;

WHEREAS, upon consultation with the officials of the Department of Education Division of City Schools, it is but proper to suspend classes in the elementary and secondary levels during the grand opening parade to ensure maximum participation of the public to the scheduled events for the month-long festivities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAURICIO G. DOMOGAN, City Mayor, Baguio City, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the following:

SECTION 1. Classes in the elementary and high school levels, both private and public, on Friday, 01 February 2019 are hereby suspended to pave the way for the conduct of the grand opening parade.

SECTION 2. The City Public Information Office under the City Mayor's Office, the Department of Education- Division of City Schools, and the Baguio City Police Office- Traffic Management Branch are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this order.

SECTION 3. All executive issuances and orders inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 4. This order shall take effect on the aforesaid date.
