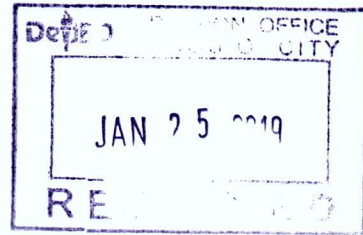





Greetings!

The PSHS-CARC Debate Varsity is pleased to invite you to the **Lumawig Cup 2019**. It is a debate competition open to all interested high school debaters and observers in Baguio City and its nearby locations. It will be held at **Philippine Science High School CAR Campus on March 9-10, 2019**.

This is in line with the Debate Varsity's SYP students' SCALE project and the overall goal of the PSHS CARC Debate Varsity to be a part of strengthening the Baguio high school debate circuit. It will provide an avenue for discourse and critical thinking especially when it comes to international, local, socio-political, and scientific issues. Moreover, participants would be given the chance to be adjudicated by some of the most accomplished Baguio debaters.

For the second year of the Lumawig Cup, the participants would be competing in Asian Parliamentary format which has two teams with three speakers each in every round. All debaters would enter four preliminary rounds with the top eight teams advancing to the quarterfinals. The top ten debaters with the highest speaker scores would be recognized.

The tournament cap is set at 30 teams, with each institution allowed to send a maximum of five teams. The registration fee would be PhP 300.00 for each team (PhP 100.00 per head), PhP 100.00 for coaches, and PhP 100.00 for observers. It will be inclusive of debate kits, lunch, and tokens and certificates.

Attached are the details of the competition, including schedules and contact information.

## TOURNAMENT DETAILS

- **Eligibility to Join**

-All high school debaters enrolled in the same institution regardless of year level and/or strand are allowed to form a team. One team must have three (3) debaters.

- **Format and Rounds**

-Lumawig cup shall be conducted in **Asian Parliamentary Debate** format. Each team would be having **four preliminary rounds**. The first round of the preliminary rounds would have match-ups determined randomly and the succeeding match-ups would be determined through power matching. The eight top-ranking teams would be selected based on wins and then by aggregate speaker points. The top eight teams would be advancing straight to quarterfinals. The ninth and tenth team would be recognized as reserve breaks and would be needed for the second day if ever a breaking team bows out of the competition.

-For the high rounds, there will be a total of **three rounds: quarterfinals, semifinals, and the grand finals**. Only the winning team would advance to a higher round, cutting the number of teams advancing by half every round.

- **Tournament Cap, Institution Cap, and Breaking Cap**

-The tournament cap is set at **30 teams**. Each institution is allowed to send a maximum of **five teams**. The slots will be determined by first come-first served basis. Only eight teams will be breaking to quarterfinals, four to semifinals, and two to the grand finals.

-Each institution must have only one coach. They also have the option of sending one reserve team.

- **Adjudication Core**

-The adjudication core will be comprised of collegiate debaters and professionals in Northern Luzon with varying achievements along the area of debating. They play a vital role during the competition by ensuring the proper quality of motions and

adjudication for the duration of the competition and to settle any conflict that may arise among the participants and the pool of adjudicators.

- **Registration Details**

- Each team would pay PhP 300.00 as registration fee (PhP 100.00 per head). It will cover the team' s lunch, debate kits, and awards they will incur throughout the competition.

- To register, please contact our head of communications or send an email to us and coordinate for slots. The registration form is attached. Payment shall be made preferably two weeks before the event and may be done personally by meet-ups.

- Since lunch and snacks will be provided, please inform us beforehand about any allergies or diet restrictions.

## TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

1) The release of motions will be done 30 minutes before the start of each round. The scope of the motions would include but are not limited to issues in relation to local and world politics, international relations and economics, religion, pop-culture and media, sports, science and technology and the state of the environment.

2) A Mandatory Point-of-Information rule will be applicable throughout the competition. This rule will ensure that each speaker would accept at least one point of information during his/her constructive speech.

3) The use of online and/or softcopy resources such as internet articles, saved pdf's, the use of phones and tablets, and anything of like nature is strictly prohibited.

4) Sharing of matter and information during the given 30-minute preparation time with any person other than a teammate is also prohibited.

5) To determine the results of the competition, the adjudicators for the debate rounds will adhere to the use of issue-based standards of adjudication, evaluating the debate using basic manner, matter, and method standards.

6) Results are deemed final and irrevocable. Proper action will be taken if any complaint is channeled by the competitors (and not by any other person) to the adjudication core. The tournament directors take a stand for a no harassment policy towards adjudicators.

7) Ironing (the act of only one team member representing an entire team) will only be allowed during the first round of the first day.
