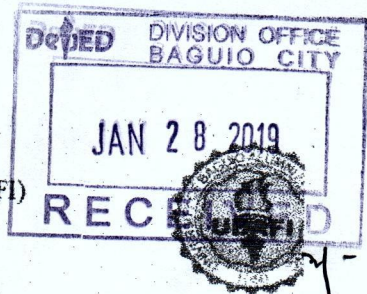

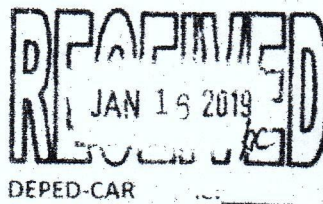

SEARCH FOR BEST COMIC

Theme: Remembering the Departed

GUIDELINES:

1. The competition is open to all students enrolled in high school in the Cordillera Administrative Region.
2. The comic illustration must be done through manual drawing. Digital illustration is not allowed.
3. Individual and group entries are allowed. For group entries, there should be a maximum of 3 members.
4. Each school is allowed 2 entries only.
5. The comic should depict the grief and mourning practices in any province of the Cordillera Administrative Region.
6. The deadline for the submission of entries is January 31, 2019. The venue and awarding of winners shall be announced on a later date.
7. Two entries per province shall be chosen as winners, provided they have met the cut off score of 75. The first place shall receive P2,000.00 and the second shall receive P1,000.00. Winning entries shall become the joint property of UBAFI and the artists/illustrators.
8. A summary of the story depicted in the comic should be written in a separate page. The summary paper contains the following parts:
 - Title of the story
 - Author/s
 - The Story (limit of 1,000 words)

Requirements for the comic:

1. Use a long US bond paper. One bond paper should have five boxes. Margin should be 1" on all sides.
2. The maximum number of pages is 10 (not back to back). The first page is not counted.
3. The artist/s has/have the choice to use any drawing and coloring materials he/they want.
4. The first page should contain the title of the story, name of artist/artist, grade level, and school.
5. Use Filipino language.

Criteria for Judging:

| CRITERIA | SCORE |

| Storyline (logical flow of the story, lessons from the dialogues) | 35 |
| Aesthetic value (neatness, harmony of colors) | 15 |
