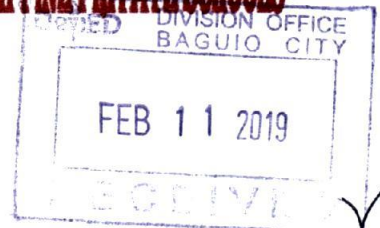

III. General Guidelines

3.1 The participants of the National YES.O Symposium is open to winners of ASMEPPS Regional YES.O Contests and other interested Preschool to Grade 12 YES.O Enthusiasts of public and private schools.

3.2 The Registration Fee is Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php750.00) per pax inclusive of : Certificate of Participation, Simple Kit, Symposium Fee and Contest Registration Fee. A participant is allowed to choose only ONE of the contests.

3.3 Confirmation of participation, submission of registration form and payment of registration fee should be received by the association on or before February 20, 2019 Thursday thru our asmepps@yahoo.com email. 3.4 Top Three(3) winners in the individual category will be awarded with Glass Medals and Certificate of Merit.

3.5 All protests should be raised to the Chairman of the Board of Judges for each event whose final decision is deemed final and irrevocable.

V. CONTEST MECHANICS AND CRITERIA

1. Environmental Quiz:

1.1 Number of Required Participants: team composed of 3 categories Intermediate; Junior High School and Senior High School

1.3 Time Duration: Easy Questions: 15 seconds; Average Questions: 20 seconds; Difficult Questions: 25 seconds

1.4 Rules and Guidelines:

1.4.1 Items shall be categorized as easy, average and difficult questions. Each shall compose of 5 items. One correct answer under the easy level corresponds to 1 point; average level, 2 points; difficult level, 3 points.

1.4.2. The quiz master shall read the question twice, then give a signal for the start of the time. Contestants must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed.

- 1.4.3 In the event of a tie, a sudden death portion will commence to break the tie
- 1.4.4 All protests shall be raised immediately before the next question is read. Protests shall be directed to the Chairman of the Board and shall be decided upon by the board whose decision is deemed final and irrevocable.
- 1.4.5 Award: Glass Medal and Certificate of Merit will be awarded to top three winners.

2. Slogan Making:

- 2.1 Category of the Contest: Intermediate and High School Level(JrHS and SrHS)
- 2.2 Time Duration: 1.5 hours
- 2.3 Rules and Guidelines:
 - 1. Participants should provide their own materials.
 - 2. The materials to be used are : ¼ Illustration Board; pentel pen, pencil and ruler
 - 3. The slogan should be written in English and the number of words should not be more than 15 words and minimum of 10 words.
 - 4. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of design.
 - 5. The decision of the board of judges is FINAL and irrevocable.
- 2.4 Criteria:
 - Relevance to the theme: 40%
 - Clarity of Message: 20%
 - Creativity: 15%
 - Originality 15%
 - Impact and Presentation: 10% Total: 100%
- 2.5 Award: Glass Medal and Certificate of Merit will be awarded to top three winners.

3. Mosaic Art

- 3.1 There are three (3) categories of the competition: Intermediate which includes Grade School; Junior High School and Senior High School
- 3.2 The participants should be composed of Five(5) members.
- 3.3 The teams are given 1 hour to finish their work. Judging starts at 3pm.
- 3.4 Participants are allowed to use CRAYONS only in addition to the materials provided by the association.
- 3.5 Entries will be judged as follows: Adherence to the Rules: 20%; Visual Impact: 20%; Cleanliness: 20%; Originality: 20% and Creativity: 20%. Total: 100%
- 3.6 The decision of the Board of Judges is Final and Irrevocable.

4. Envi-Sci Spell : Grade 3 to 12

- 4.1 The participants of the **Envi-Sci Spell** starts from Grade Three (3) to Grade Twelve(12). It will be a Final Oral Test. The participants should bring their own white board marker. Paper will be provided by the association.
- 4.2 The quiz master shall read the word twice, its meaning and in the case of a scientists name, his/her accomplishments. The contestants shall start writing on the given answer sheet after the quizmaster gives the GO signal. Answers should be written legibly observing capitalization for proper nouns. Grade 3and4, 5and6, 7and8, 9and10 and 11and12 shall have the same set of questions.
- 4.3 The words to be spelled in the contest are names and terms related to Science. The contestants will be given 15 words to spell. Easy words with Average words with 2 points each and Difficult words with 3 points each. Environmental 1 pt each.

5. Solo Singing

- 5.1 There are Three levels of competition: Grade School, Junior High School and Senior High School.
- 5.2 The song to be presented should be a song sung by the group of ASIN. Bring proof in case of doubt.
- 5.3 The performance time should only last for four (4) minutes.
- 5.4. Criteria: Voice Quality: 40%; Interpretation:25%; Diction and Timing:25%; Stage Presence:10%

6. Interpretative Dance Contest

- 6.1 There are four Levels of Competition: Preschool, Grade School, Junior High School and Senior High School.
- 6.2 Group should be composed of Ten (10) members only.
- 6.3. The group should interpret the song "Kapaligiran"
- 6.4. The performance time should only last for 5-7 minutes. Exceeding minutes shall merit point deductions from the total score. (1 minute=1 point)

7. Team/Theme Modeling

- 7.1 There are Four Levels of Competition: Preschool, Grade School, JHS and SHS
- 7.2 The group should be composed of Five (5) members, either male or female or combination of both.
- 7.3 The maximum performance time is 3 minutes.
- 7.4 The theme for the attire is any recycled wear.
- 7.5 Criteria for Judging:

- 8.2 The contest will only focus on Science News Writing (English and Filipino), Science Feature Writing (English and Filipino) and Science Photo Journalism.
- 8.3 Things to bring: Science News Writing and Science Feature Writing (Writing Material-Black Ballpen) and Science Photo Journalism (DSLR Camera or any digital camera).

9.4.1. Must be original composition in Filipino

9.4.2. Acapella is allowed or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment at the composers discretion.

9.4.4. May use props made up of recycled materials and available resources.

Visual Impact: 20%

10.4 Award: Glass Medals and Certificate of Merit will be awarded to top three winners.

11. Jigsaw Puzzle

11.1 Participants: Preschool (Kinder 1/ Kinder 2);

Team Competition- composed of 2 pupils per level

11.2 Materials will be provided by the association

11.3 Criteria: Length of Time Finished(50%) and Quality of the Portion of the Puzzle Finished(50%)
