SCHOOL- BASED PANAGBENGA QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES FOR THE QUIZ BEE

1. The coverage of the quiz is about the **PANAGBENGA**
2. The participants are **Grade 4 learners** coming from public and private schools. Four pupils from each District (Two pupils from public schools and two pupils from private schools).
3. During the quiz, participants will be provided with writing materials.
4. *English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.*
5. Participants will be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy", seven (7) are "average" and seven (7) are "difficult".
6. Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:
 - One (1) point for each "easy" question
 - Two (2) points for each "average" question
 - Three (3) points for each difficult question.
7. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question.
8. All ties shall be broken by a tie breaker question from the difficult category.
9. The quiz master will read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
10. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed.
 - Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
 - The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges who will recognize then protest or inquiry.
 - The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.
11. Top three winners will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring. They will be receiving cash prizes and certificate of recognition and certificate of participation of the non- winners.

Event Rules and Mechanics:	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. All officially enrolled learners with LRN ARE ELIGIBLE TO JOIN b. The event administrators, technical Committee members and judges, should be in the venue 60 minutes ahead of the event schedule. c. Contestants will be provided food for they are not allowed to go out of the contest venue during break time. d. All contestants should be at the designated venue 30 minutes before the event starts. Late participants without valid reason shall be disqualified. e. The event Administrator will let the contestants draw lots to determine their respective places and set up their tools and materials on their assigned places. Setting up of their extension cords, equipment, and tools should be done during this time f. Briefing of contestants will be fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled events. g. The event administrator will signal for the event to begin. Once the event has started, the coaches, teachers, are no longer allowed to talk to the participant to give them full concentration in their work. h. Only the event Administrator, technical committee members, judges, official photographer and contestants are allowed in the venue. i. Contestant may seek clarification with event administrator and facilitators at any given time. 	

- j. Should there be any irregularities found during the event, the Event administrator in consultation with the board of judges may suspend the conduct of the specific skill exhibition if justified and refer the matter to the attention of the technical working members for appropriate action.
- k. Borrowing of materials, tools, supplies during the event is not allowed.
- l. Uniform materials will be provided by the organizer. Contestants may use accessories other than given to them but shall remain with the organizers.
- m. The finished dish garden shall be ready for photography, sketching after all the members of the board of judges shall have finished their individual rating
- n. A sketches by the contestants (Long size bond paper) will be submitted to the administrator after the execution.
- o. The entries shall remain untouched to be displayed as property of the Schools Division Office.
- p. Each contestant will go through a panel interview and deliberation with board of judges after the four (4) hours' time allotment.
- q. Interview will be done one at a time using uniform question
- r. The working area should be cleaned by the contestants immediately after every event.
- s. The contestant must provide all the materials (assorted plants not to exceed five hundred pesos (Php500.00)
- t. Proof of purchased of material actually used must be provided
- u. Used of Recycled materials are highly encouraged.
- v. The maximum dimension is 2 x 2 x 2 ft (length,width and height whether circular or triangular)

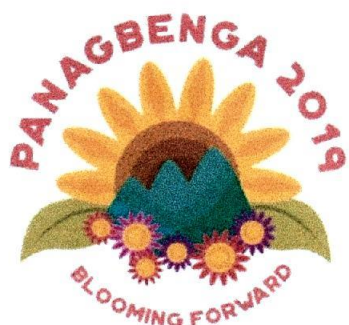

JUDGING CRITERIA

- A. **20% Steadiest Kite** – Is the least active kite in the air
- B. **30% Construction, Originality, Creativity and Design** – Judges will look for an ORIGINAL, UNIQUE, ODD, and STRIKING KITE
- C. **50% Kite Size** – Square Footage of the sail area will determine the size of the kite

CONTEST RULES

FREE REGISTRATION. OPEN TO EVERYONE.

1. All minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for registration for registration and during the contest.
2. Contestants must bring their kite for registration.
3. Contestants must register before the contest and display their number at all times.
4. Contestants may enter only one kite (One contestant, one kite).
5. The participant may choose any material he/she desires to use for his/her entry. It may be paper, cloth or any similar light material such as wood, bamboo, etc. and metal connectors.

6. Kites must be original and has not been used in previous Panagbenga Kite flying Competitions. The Philippine Flag or similar representations of the Philippine Flag cannot be used.
7. Kites below 9 square feet may only use one runner. Kites above 10 square feet may be allowed to be flown with a second runner.
8. Inexpensive material and use of recycled materials are HIGHLY encouraged. The participants will be provided assistance by marshals during the launch.
9. The kites shall be given a 5-minute launch period and a retry for failure to take-off; kites that fail to take-off the second time are disqualified; a kite that gets entangled may be flown again with clearance from the organizers.
10. If the weather doesn't permit or the winds are too low, the judges may implement the "No Flying Condition Regulations." Under these conditions, participant's kites will be judged without flying.
11. If a kite is damaged during the competition, the kite-maker may try to repair the kite. A damage repair area will be available for kite-makers to repair their kites. If the kite is able to be repaired, it may be launched again to determine if it will meet the one (1) minute flying regulation.
12. Friends and family members may assist in the launching and repairing of kites. but the kite must be flown by the kite-maker.
13. All decisions of the judges are final.
