A series of activities will be conducted to celebrate these two commemorations. Among these activities are the **CREATIVE PAINTING COMPETITION, ESSAY WRITING and ORATORICAL CONTEST**. These activities will be collaboratively organized and sponsored by the Department of Education (DepEd), Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP), Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) and the Department of National Defense (DND). Details of these two significant events, including the contest mechanics are provided in the attached Enclosures 1 and 1a, 2 and 2a, 3 and 3a respectively.

Relative to this, please be informed that travel and other incidental expenses of the identified winners, coaches, during the awarding ceremonies shall be charged against local funds, regional/division/school PTCA, School Board Funds (SBF) or to other sources and grants, subject to the fund availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

All Regional and Division officials, teachers and employees who will attend the flag raising and wreath laying ceremonies on April 9, 2019 at all sites and venue shall be given one-day service credits.

77th ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK

CONTEST MECHANICS ORATORICAL CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 students enrolled in any public secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

2. Theme and Content

The **Oratorical piece must be in Filipino, original**, never been published, and expounding on the theme: **"PAMANANG KALAYAAN NG MGA BETERANO: ISABUHAY AT PAGYAMANIN NG LAHING PILIPINO."**

The **piece** must be delivered for a **minimum of seven (7) minutes** and a **maximum of 10 minutes**.

The oration **SHOULD NOT**, in whole or in part, expressly or impliedly offend any race, religious freedom, nor should it be against the laws of environment, honor and dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.

3. Criteria

a. Content	Sincerity, originality and relevance to the theme	50%
b. Delivery	Posture, gesture, eye contact, facial expression, Pronunciation, volume and mastery	40%
c. Persuasion and Stage Presence		10%
Total		100%

4. Regional Qualifiers

Each region should have one contestant in the Oratorical Contest to represent the region in the National Level. Regions may conduct a Regional Level Competition or select a regional representative to compete in the National Level.

5. Submission

All regional representatives to the National Level Contest shall submit four (4) copies of their oratorical piece to the External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU) upon their arrival at the hotel.

6. Attire

During the final competition, the contestants **shall wear the appropriate attire:**

- o Boys - Barong
- o Girls - Simple Filipiniana Dress

7. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The contestant who will get the highest points shall be considered as the National Champion, the contestant with the second highest points shall be declared as the first runner-up, and the contestant with the third highest score shall be declared as the second runner-up.

Winners will be announced after the final competition on **April 8, 2019** at Richville Hotel Manila and will be awarded at Mount Samat Shrine, Bataan on **April 9, 2019**.

8. Logistics

Travel expenses (transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses) of the contestants/coaches/during the awarding ceremonies shall be charged against local funds or sourced from NGOs, municipality/city funds and/or civic spirited clubs and organizations subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Board and lodging, land and air travel (tickets) of the participants (1 contestant and 1 coach shall be charged against Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

10. Prizes

The Organizing Committee shall make suitable arrangements to ensure the provisions of the prizes for the competition.

11. Copyright

The concerned agencies have the right to publish the selected contest pieces and the right to determine other matters not included under the rules.

12. The decision of the Board of Judges is final, non-appealable and irrevocable.
