

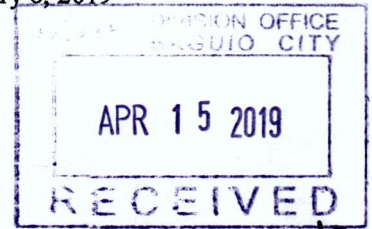

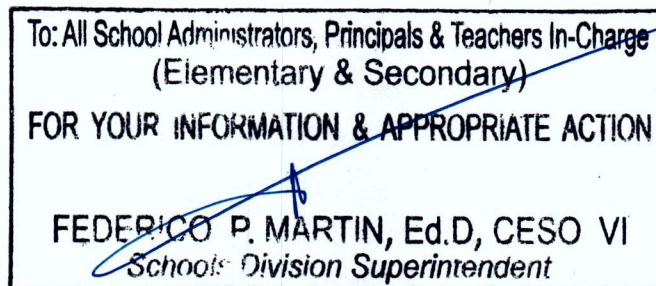
We would like to invite interested teachers and students to join in the Saceda Youth Lead International Programs for SY 2019-2020.

During the program, participants will attend meetings with local government, visit institutions to meet local leaders in government, interact with students and teachers and to promote peace and mutual understanding.

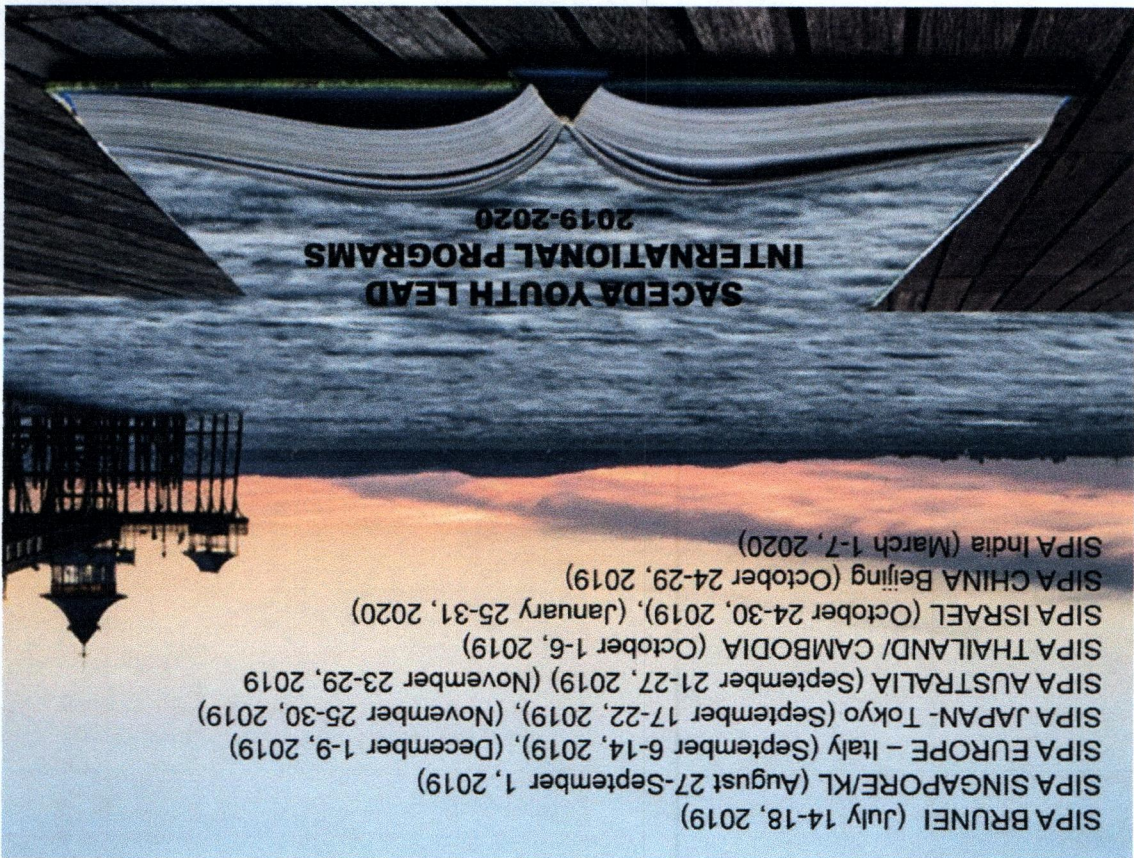

Filing of visas to enter Australia must be done at 60-90 days prior to the date of departure. The documents needed are the following:

1. Photocopy of the passport and old passports with issued visas
2. Duly accomplished application forms AUS 956A, AUS 1419, AUS 0614
3. Passport sized picture
4. Income Tax Return/ W2 Form Tax Withheld
5. Certificate of Employment
6. Bank Certification
7. Bank Transactions for the past 2 months
8. Birth Certificate PSA (including BC of children and marriage certificates)
9. SYL Invitation Letters and Programme

Visas are processed by authorized Travel Agents or representatives and all documents submitted will be assessed prior to visa application. Approved visas will be released via email. This document shall be presented by the delegate upon departure in Manila and arrival in Sydney.

All minor delegates must process a DSWD Certificate of Eligibility to Travel for Minors. Parents must comply with requirements with DSWD Provincial Office for their own procedures.
