

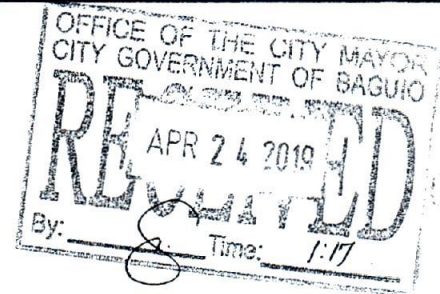

Dear Mayor Domogan:

This is in pursuant to **CSC Announcement No. 40, series of 2017** (Implementation of Values Restoration Program):

We are the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values, a Civil Society Organization tasked by the Civil Service Commission to conduct Values Restoration Program (VRP) to all personnel, officers and staff, of all government departments, agencies, bureaus, offices including government owned and controlled corporations under the Civil Service Announcement No. 40 s. 2017. The Values Restoration Program is the perceived antidote to the problem of graft and corruption, inefficiency and broken working relationships between government employees. In line with this is the appointment of Values Restoration Officers who are organic employees of your prestigious local government unit, at least two (2) each from the **executive, legislative or department**, one from the rank and file and the other from the supervisory or department head level. We would also encourage the appointment of a VRO from the Local Youth Development Council of your unit. This, however, requires training prior to their appointment.



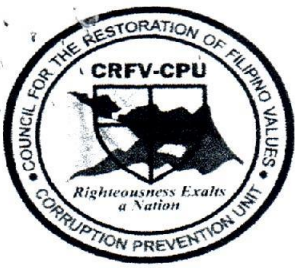

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

Discuss the overview of the VRP with the agency head/supervisor and submit an action plan for their office or agency as approved by the head of the agency;

Read and study the manual on Transforming the Nation Through Values and familiarize themselves with the schedule of an assigned topic for the Weekly Value Focus (P.I.E.S.) as the subject is simultaneously discussed in agencies implementing VRP in the entire nation;

Lead the 7-minute discussion of the Weekly Value Focus during the Flag ceremony and organize a 10-20 minute small group discussions among the employees in the agency reflecting on the weekly value focus delivered during the flag ceremony;

Submit documented quarterly reports on the progress, innovations and other related activities pertaining to the implementation of the Values Restoration Program. Such reports are submitted to the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV);

Coordinate all VRP matters that includes Capability Building programs necessary to enhance values, promote GMRC and establish ethical leadership in their agency; and

Update oneself by reading the supplementary value focus sent to their emails every week.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

He/she must be of good moral character and active advocate of good governance by modeling it before the other government personnel;

He/she is of good conduct based on the evaluation of his/her Head of Office and based on the judgement and general observation of his/her co-employees in the agency;

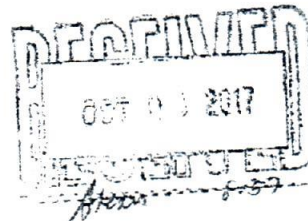
He/she should have been one of the best performing employees in the government agency and have not been held guilty or liable of nonfeasance, misfeasance, or malfeasance in office or of any flagrant violation of laws and reasonable rules and regulations of the agency.

He/she must be between 30-60 years of age.



SUBJECT : Values Restoration Program

The Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV), a Civil Service Commission Accredited Learning and Development Institution, aims to introduce its **Values Restoration Program** as a soft approach of the government's anti-corruption initiatives.

In line with this, government agencies are encouraged to support the program by appointing at least two Values Restoration Officers (VRO) from supervisory level and rank and file from their central, regional, provincial, and field offices or units. The designated VRO shall lead the discussion of a common value every week after the flag ceremony using the CRFV-authored book **transforming the Nation through Values** and the CD with Powerpoint presentations containing the same. Moreover, the designated VRO shall coordinate all VRP matters in their agencies and attend the Trainer's Trainings and other seminars and meetings to be conducted by the CRFV.

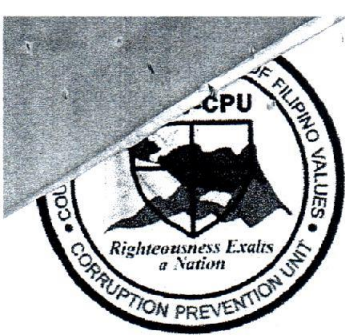

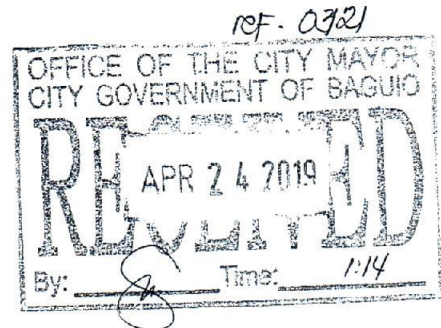

Greetings of peace from the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values.




