EVALUATION AND VALIDATION OF LEARNING MATERIALS IN THE PRIVATE SCHOOLS

To: **Curriculum Implementation Division
Private School Administrators/School Heads/Principals
All Others Concerned**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 320 Series 2018 entitled "Compliance of Private Schools on the Evaluation of Learning Resources (Books, Modules and other Learning Materials) as a Requirement in the Issuance of Government Permit/Recognition" and in preparation for school year 2019-2020, the Schools Division Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will be conducting the validation of available learning resources especially textbooks.
