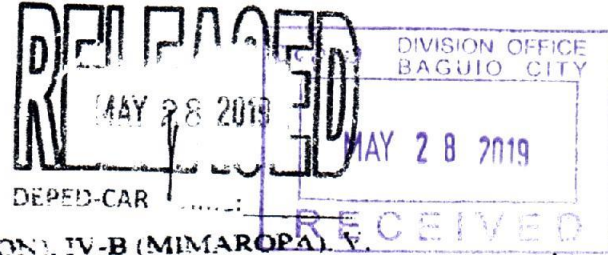

The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) is calling for applications for the 2019 UNESCO International Literacy Prizes with the theme "Literacy and Multilingualism."

The UNESCO International Literacy Prizes aim to recognize excellence and innovation of individuals and organizations in the field of literacy while seeking to support effective literacy practices and encourage the promotion of dynamic literacy societies.

There are currently two UNESCO International Literacy Prizes:

- a. The UNESCO King Sejong Literacy Prize with the thematic vision of "development and use of mother-tongue literacy education and training"
- b. The UNESCO Confucius Prize for Literacy with the thematic vision of "literacy amongst adults in rural areas and out-of-school youth, particularly girls and women"

In this regard, concerned parties in all regions, through their divisions and schools, who have made outstanding contributions to the promotion of literacy for the past three years are invited to apply. All applications shall be submitted to the National Commission for UNESCO, the country's nominating entity, via the online platform (<http://www.unesco.org/lip/accounts>) on or before June 9, 2019.
