The ICT Industry Development Bureau (IDBI) of the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) will conduct the Philippine Startup Challenge (PSC) High School Edition. The themes are Environmental Sustainability, and Inclusive Economic Development.

The competition aims to:

1. encourage high school students to create innovative and relevant ICT applications and/or solutions.
2. introduce them to their local startup community.
3. help students and their teachers become familiar and learn startup fundamentals.
4. provide students with the opportunity to learn to translate complex problems into workable pain points, and
5. promote technopreneurship as a career option.

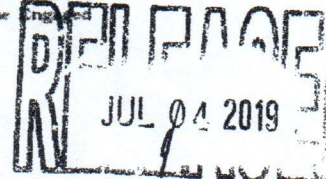
Target participants are teams of three junior/senior high school students and one faculty adviser. They may submit entries to either or both themes. Teams from the same school may have the same faculty adviser.
