



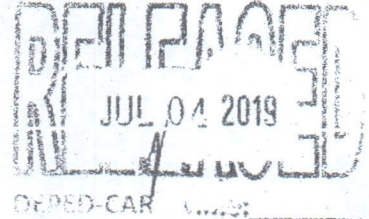

Science education aims to develop scientific literacy among learners that will prepare them to be informed and participative citizens who are able to make judgments and decisions regarding applications of scientific knowledge to their daily lives.

In line with these goals, we encourage the participation of students and teachers from both private and public schools in the celebration of the National Science and Technology Week (NSTW) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) with the theme **"Science for the People: Enabling Technologies for Sustainable Development"**, from July 17 to 21, 2019 at the World Trade Center, Pasay City, pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 169 s. 2013 entitled Declaring the Third Week of July as National Science and Technology Week. 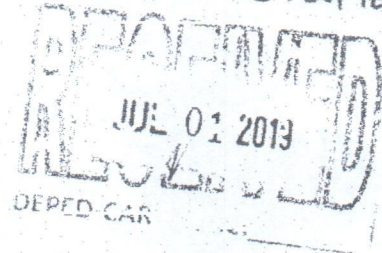
