PARTICIPANTS:

1. Each school may send a team composed of **three (3) members**.
2. The top **three** school teams in each of the provinces shall be the ones to compete in the Regional Finals.

MECHANICS OF THE QUIZ SHOW:

***The Provincial Quiz Show and the Region-Wide Quiz Show shall follow the same format.

A. WRITTEN

1. All schools must register online or on-site using the approved registration form.
2. Contestants must sit only on the designated seats as indicated in their registration forms.
3. Contestants are NOT allowed to bring any mobile device and other gadgets inside the testing room.
4. The proctor shall distribute first the scratch papers where the contestants shall solve the problems. Contestants should write their names on all the scratch papers.
5. Before distributing the test papers, the proctor should tell the contestants that they should write only their name and school on the test paper. No one should begin answering the questions unless the proctor gives the signal to do so.
6. The proctor tells the contestants that only the final answers must be written on the test paper. All solutions shall be placed on the scratch papers which should also be turned over to the proctors together with the test paper.
7. The written part shall cover Elementary Mathematics and Science, English and Abstract Reasoning.
8. The test shall be taken within 90 minutes. The proctor informs the contestants of the time limit for the test. He gives the signal for the contestants to begin. Then, he writes on the board "Time Started: ____ " and "Time Ends: ____ "
9. Proctor gives 15 minutes and 5 minutes warning before the time is up. All test and scratch papers should be collected when the time is up.

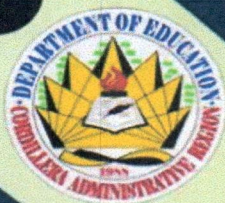
10. The proctor shall give all papers (answered test papers, scratch papers, extra copies of questions) to the person in-charge of assigning the checkers.
11. If any student submits the paper before the time, the proctor shall accept it and ask the student to leave the classroom. The proctor shall collect ALL papers when the time is up and will not allow any extension.
12. The papers shall be corrected using the answer keys provided. Each correct answer merits one point.
13. The average score of the participants shall be added to the score in the Oral Finals.
14. The top 3 individual scorers shall also be given medals and certificates.

B. ORAL FINALS

1. Each team will be provided with cardboards for the answer to each question. Before the first question, they will write their team identification on each slip.
2. There shall be 20 questions: 10 fifteen-second questions worth 2 points each, 5 thirty-second questions worth 3 points each and 5 one-minute questions worth 5 points each for a total of 60 points.
 - a. The 15-second questions are to be answered mentally. There will be no writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. The team of three will work together as one to discuss their answer to the question. They may start discussing their solution after the first reading of each question.
 - b. For the 30-second questions, scratch paper will be provided for each team contestant. Contestants may begin solving as soon as they wish.
 - c. For 1-minute questions, a copy of the questions will be provided for each team. Scratch papers will be provided.
 - d. NO additional questions should be asked over the 20 official questions provided for this stage of the competition.
3. The quizmaster will read each question twice, after which he/she gives the GO signal. The timer starts when the quizmaster gives the GO signal. The questions shall be read exactly as it is formulated. Rephrasing of the questions is not allowed.
4. Each answer will be written on the official cardboards provided. As soon as the buzzer rings, everybody must stop writing.
5. One of the judges will announce the teams with the correct answer. The scorers record the points obtained by each team for each correct answer.
6. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
7. The teams will be ranked according to their total score in the oral and written parts to determine the winners.
8. In case of a tie among any of the teams vying for the first three places, a set of 3 questions will be given to break the tie, one from each category of questions. If the tie is not broken after the three questions, "do or die" questions will be given.
9. Only the official contestants may raise a complaint or clarification.
10. Complaints on a given question should be made before the next question is asked. This should be directed to the Chairman of the Board of Judges.

ABOUT THE 2019 PISAYKLABAN QUIZ SHOW

The Philippine Science High School- Cordillera Administrative Region Campus (known as Pisay-CAR) conceptualized the *2019 Pisayklaban Quiz Show* to provide an avenue for elementary pupils in the CAR region to showcase their aptitude and passion in Science, Technology & Mathematics. This activity also aims to reach out to potential scholars of the campus.

The first phase of the Pisayklaban is the Provincial Quiz Show which will be conducted in all the provinces of CAR. WHO CAN JOIN THE 2019 PISAYKLABAN QUIZ SHOW

- Has an aptitude for Science & Technology with a final grade of 85% or better in Science and Mathematics; or in the upper 10% of the batch;
- A Filipino citizen with no pending or approved application as immigrant to any foreign country;
- Born on or after August 1, 2005; and
- Not have taken the PSHS-National Competitive Examination previously.
