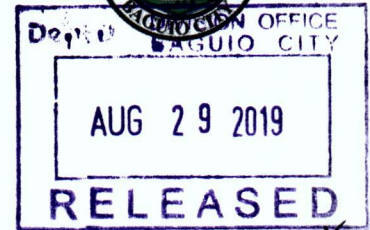

1. In preparation for the Palarong Lungsod 2019, CARAA meet, Batang Pinoy and Philippines Series 2020, this office is informing the field the use of TEE BALL Baseball and Softball in Baguio City Charter Day Cup Little League Tournament will be held on August 31, September 1,7,8,14,15,21,22,28 and 29,2019 at the Baguio Athletic Oval and Melvin Jones Ground. The registration of participants will be on August 30,2019 4:00pm onwards and opening ceremonies will be on September 1, 2019 in the same venue.
2. This TEE BALL Baseball tournament is open to all baseball and softball teams of public and private elementary and secondary schools, hence, all heads are encouraged to send as many teams as they can afford as this will be benefit your school, faculty, and students.
3. All district PESS Coordinators are requested to submit to this office the list of participating school team for recording purposes.
4. The objectives of the TEE BALL Baseball and Softball tournament are as follows:
 - a. Develop coaching and playing strategies of the game of Baseball and softball.
 - b. Develop grassroots program, teamwork among all members of a team.
 - c. Apply rigorously all acquired playing and coaching skills.
 - e. Appreciate playing baseball and softball.
5. A registration of Php200 shall be charged to each participating team to cover expenses on certificates, handouts, and other incidental expenditures. This registration fee can be charged against or any available sources, school and PTA funds which are subject to usual accounting and auditing procedure.
6. A three-day service and certificate of overtime credits shall be granted to public school teachers, coaches and administrators and non-teaching personnel respectively who will actively participate in the tournament.
7. All participating teams shall wear their own playing attires with the proper assigned color to distinguish one team from the other and for their own comfort.
