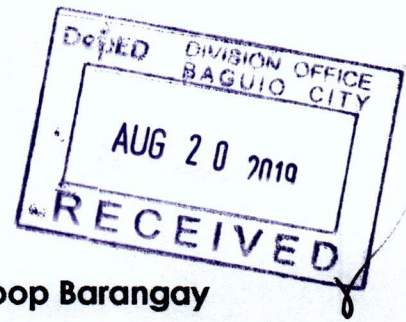

We are pleased to inform you that this year's **National Camps 2019** will be held on **December 1-6, 2019** at Cogon Eco-Tourism Park in Dipolog City, Zamboanga Del Norte . Initial details are the following:

Participants: Registered Senior Scouts or Cadet Scouts (*First Come , First Serve*)

Camp Fee: **Php 2,500** (c/o Council) per camper inclusive of program materials (Camper's Manual), certificates, badge/s, camp souvenirs (bag, shirt), group insurance, and transportation during offsite activities.

**Note: Participants will shoulder airfare going from Manila to Dipolog Airport vice-versa. Also, food provision is not included in the camp fee. Land Transportations (Baguio to Manila Airport and Dipolog Airport to Campsite) will be shouldered by the Council.*

Camper's Qualifications:

Girls

1. **Must be a registered Senior/Cadet Girl Scout as of December 2019.**
2. Must be physically fit and alert.
3. Must have earned atleast one badge each in the 8-Point Challenge.
4. Must have attended a Troop/ Patrol/ Council/Regional Camp prior to this camp.
5. Must be a Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course Certificate Holder or has attended the Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course.

Things to Bring:

The following items/things should be brought by the individual camper and packed in a **duffle bag and a backpack/knapsack** provided with luggage tags. **Travel luggage and/or Trolley Bags (Maleta) will not be allowed inside the camp.** Campers are encouraged to travel light, and bring only what is needed.
