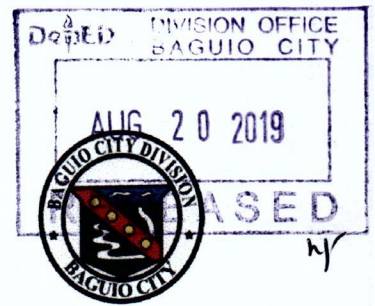


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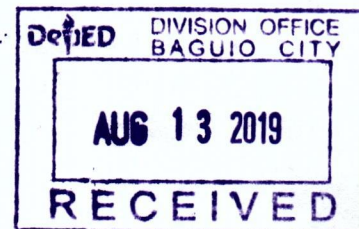

Subject: **CONDUCT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (IP) YOUTH CAMP**

Date: August 19, 2019

1. This is to inform the field that the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines in coordination with the Department of Education- Baguio City will conduct a two-day Intellectual Property Youth Camp on September 5-6, 2019 back to back with the FUN Intellectual Property activity on September 7, 2019 in Baguio City. This activity is part of the National Science Club Month Celebration every September.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. empower and inspire students in the secondary level to be more creative and innovative, and
 - b. help the students imbibe respect for intellectual property of others and value their own creation at school and in the future.
3. Participants are as follows:
 - a. Two Science Youth leaders in Grades 8 or 9 per school
 - b. One Science club adviser per school
4. Venue will be announced later. Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOP HL) will shoulder cost of meals and accommodation of the participants.
5. Schools Heads /School Science coordinators are to submit the names of the participants to the Division Science supervisor on or before August 23, 2019.

Dear Superintendent Martin:

One of the Strategic Goals of the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOP HL) is to *increase the level of appreciation of, respect for, and utilization of intellectual property (IP)*. IPOP HL believes that the youth, being potential creators, inventors, and artists in the future, should be educated early on the relevance of IP. As it is in secondary education, where **students begin to do research and are being prepared to choose their own careers**, the IPOP HL would like to empower and inspire students in the secondary level to be more **creative and innovative**, and help them imbibe respect for IP of others and value their own creation at school and in the future.


To pursue this objective, IPOP HL initiated to organize the **Young IP Advocates (YIPA)** in 2013. It aims to bring together select students coming from secondary schools in one venue. Through a 2-day IP youth camp, the YIPAs are provided with information, orientation and workshop exercises on understanding and appreciating IP.

In this regard, we would like to invite the **Special Science/DOST Curriculum of the Secondary Schools in Baguio City** to send two of their youth leaders, preferably 8th or 9th grade students, and one faculty member per school as participants in this activity. Further, a one-day fun activity with the families of participating students will also be organized after the two-day Camp. The IP Youth Camp is scheduled on September 5-6 back to back with the FUN IP activity on September 7 in Baguio City with the exact venue to be communicated with you shortly. IPOP HL will shoulder cost of meals and accommodation of participants during the events. Attached with this letter is the confirmation sheet.
